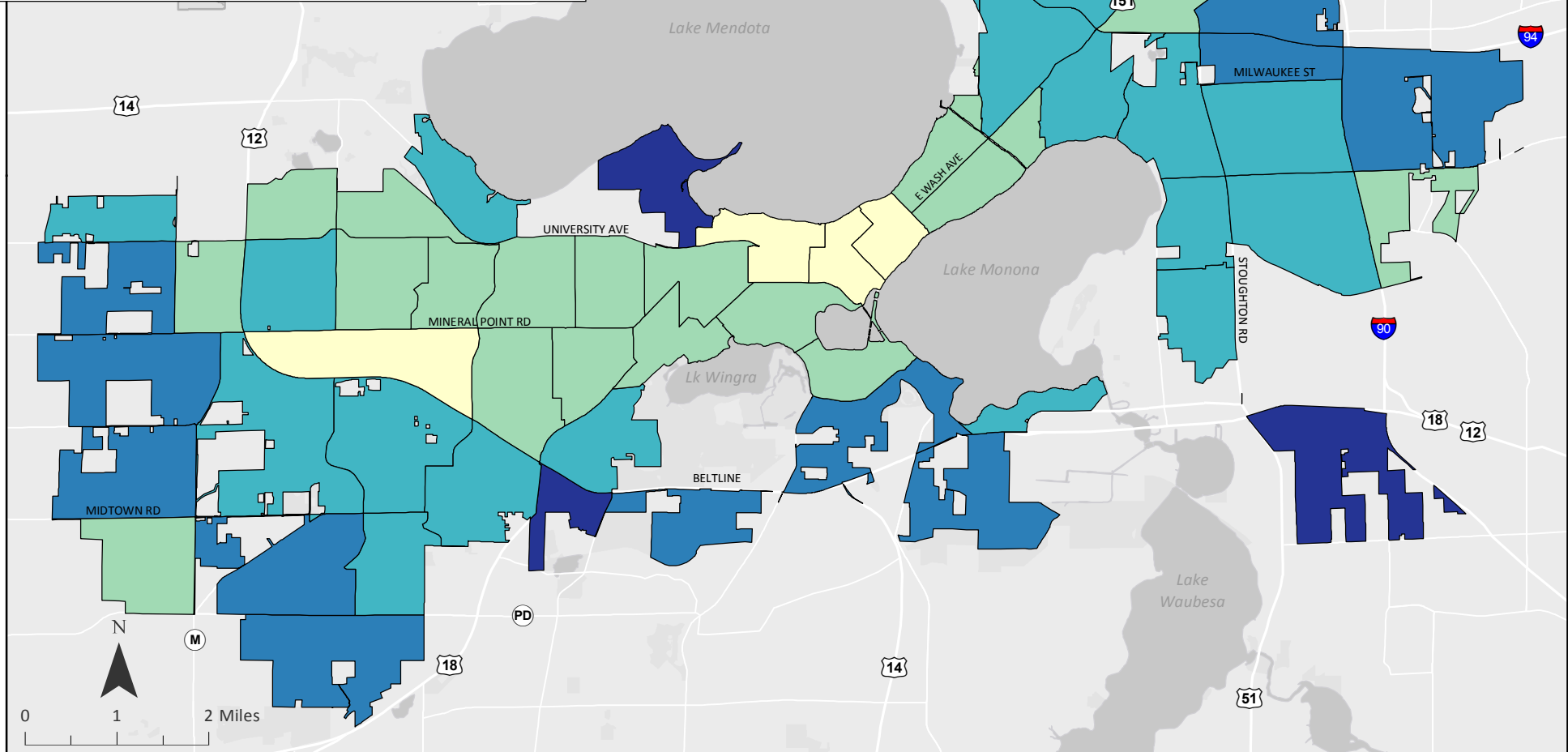

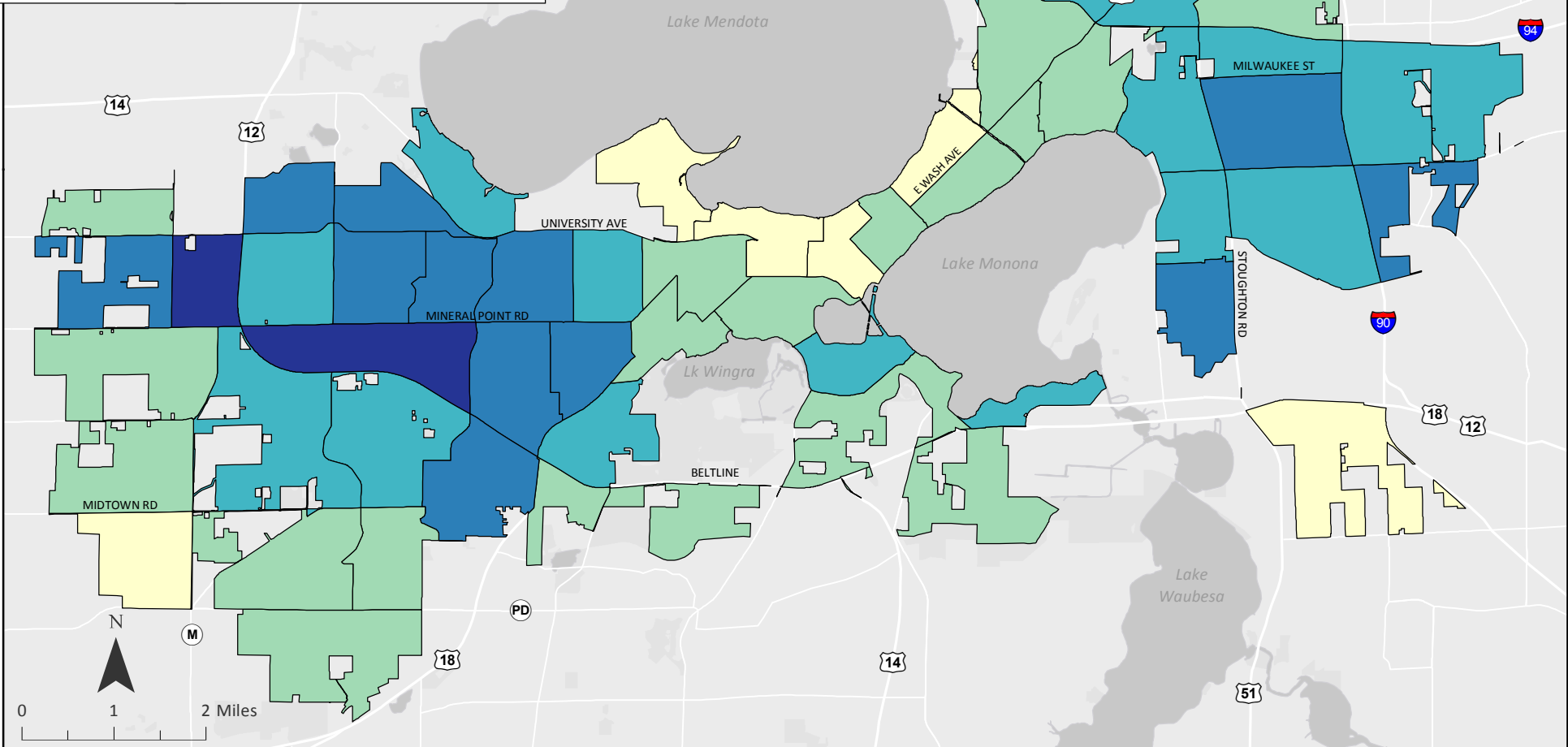

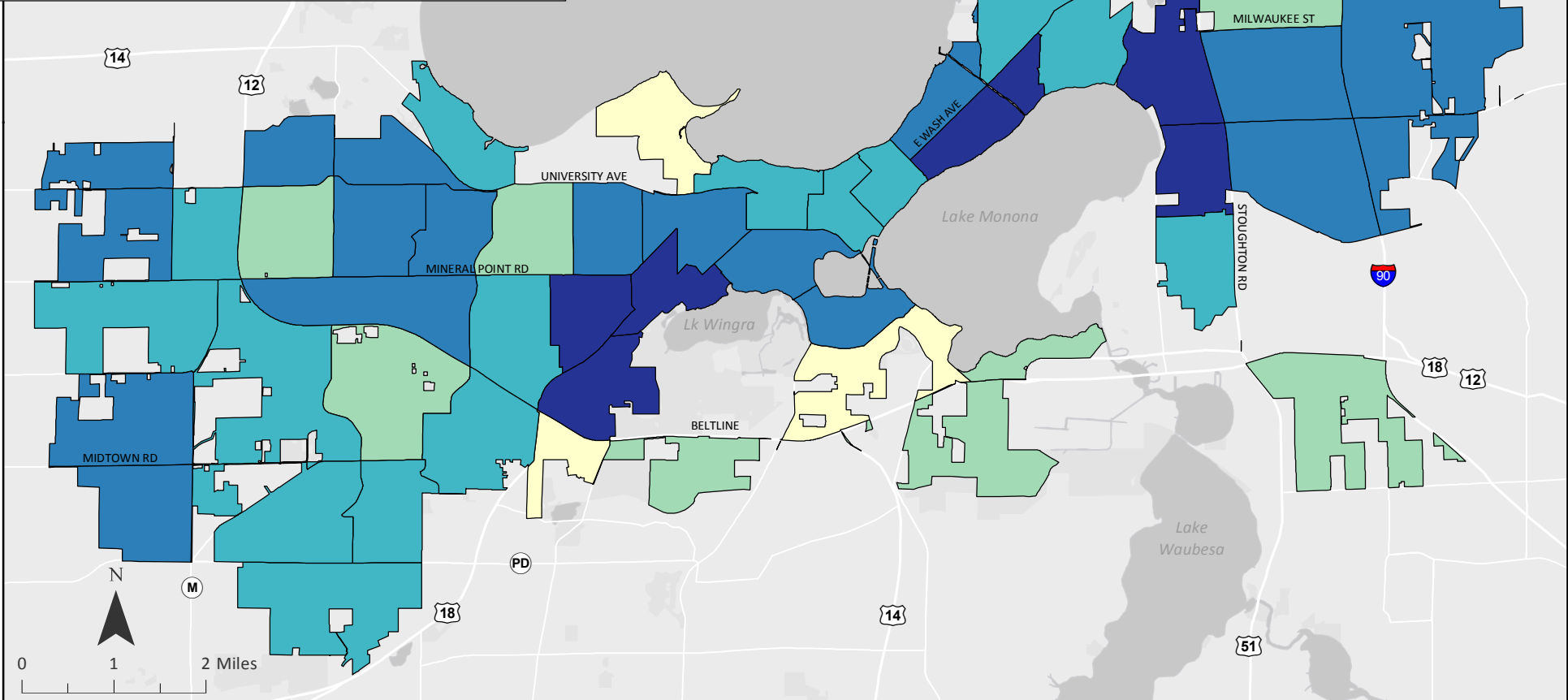

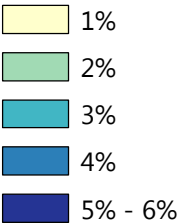

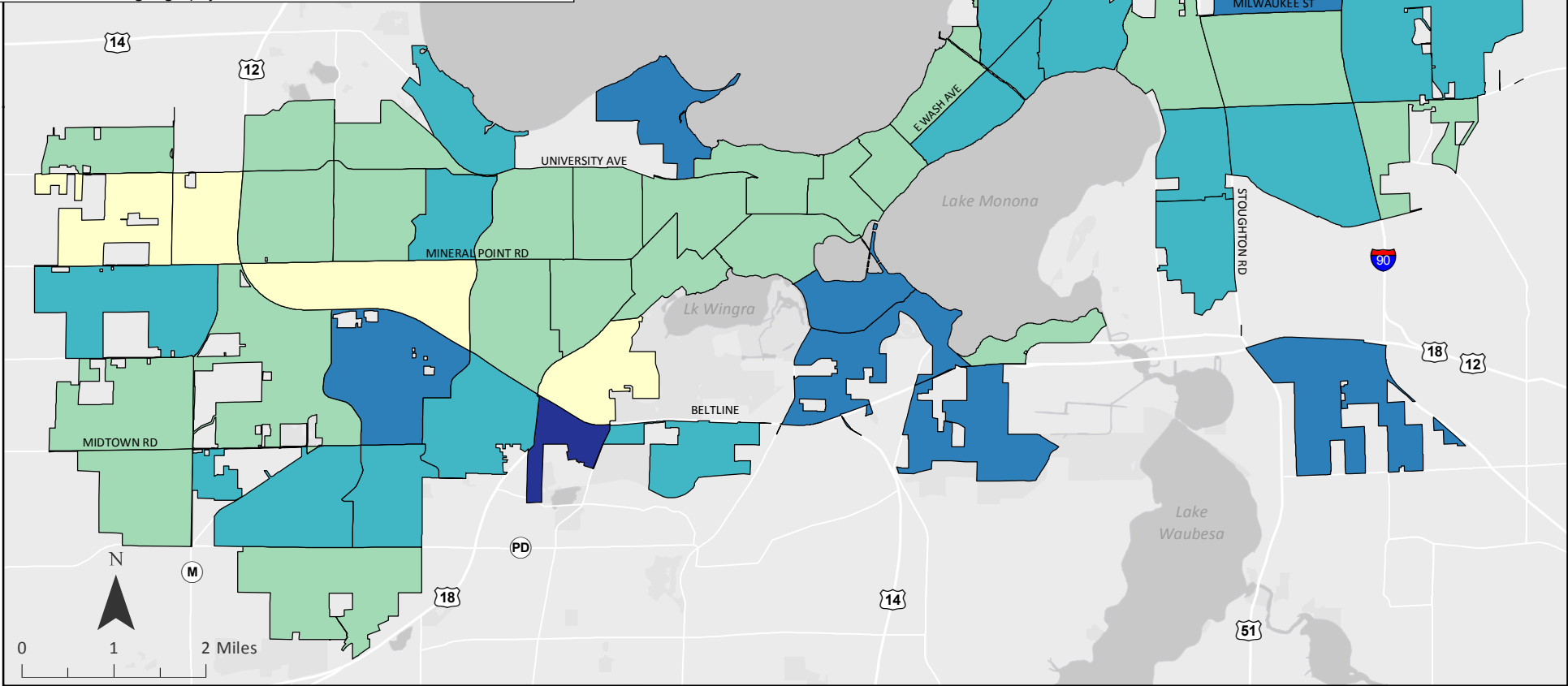

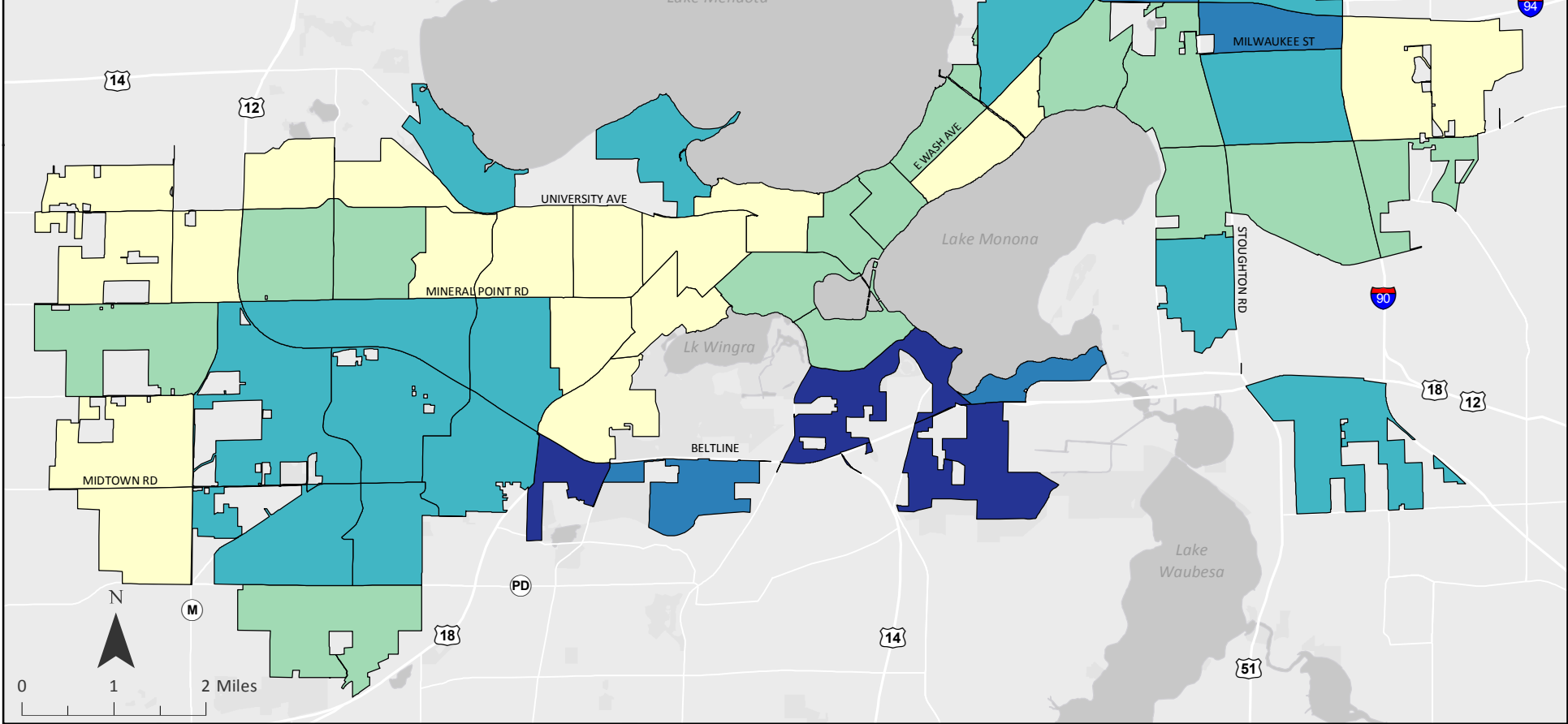

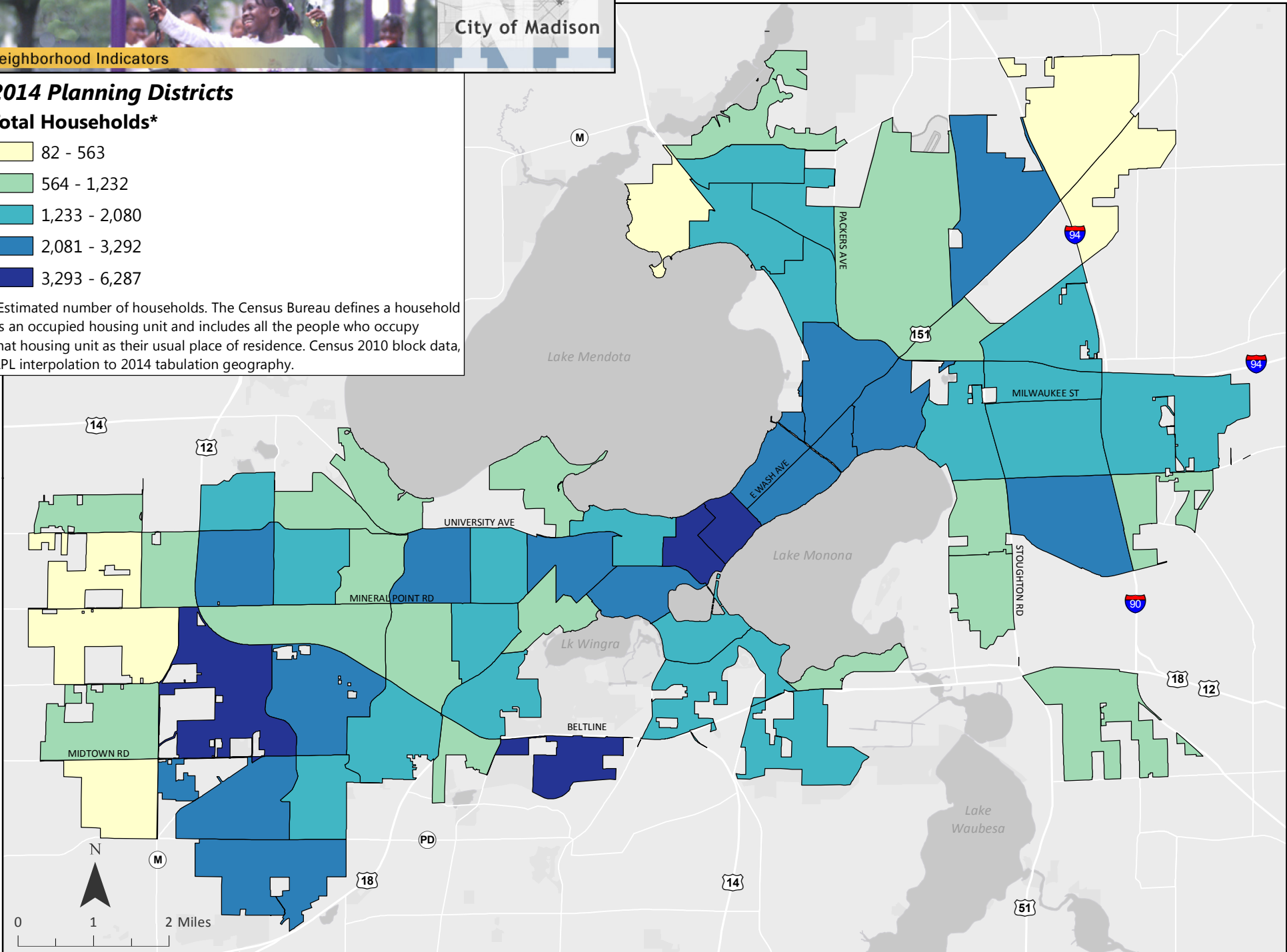

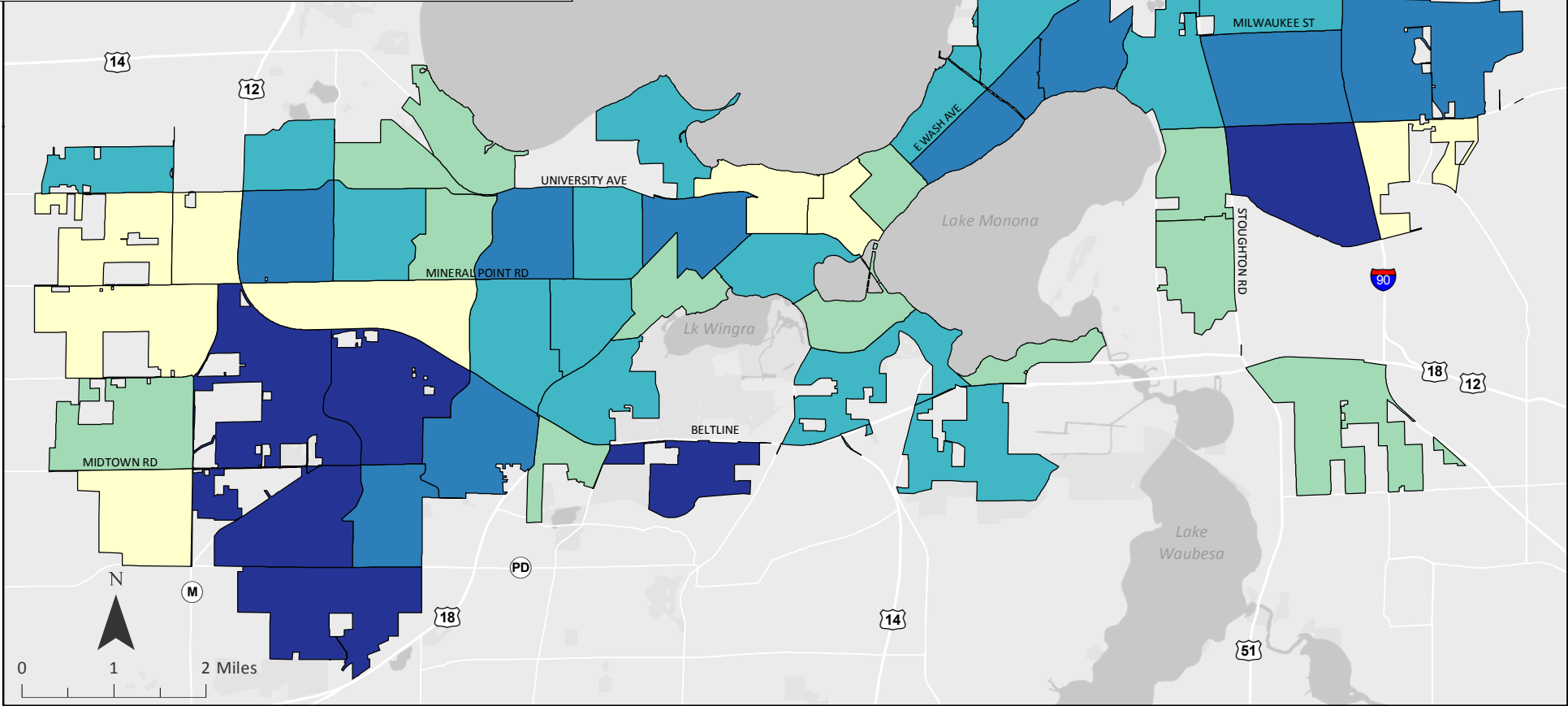

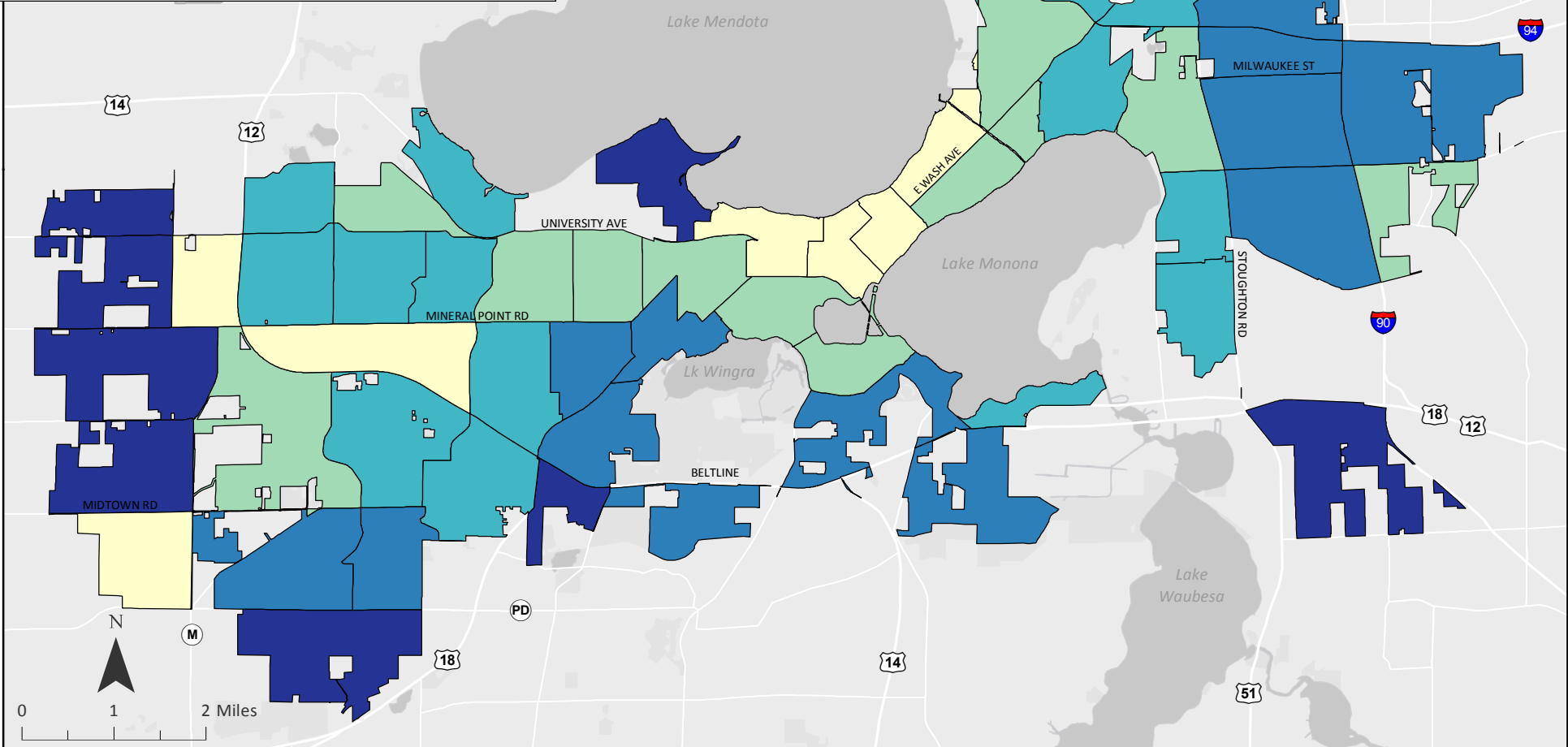

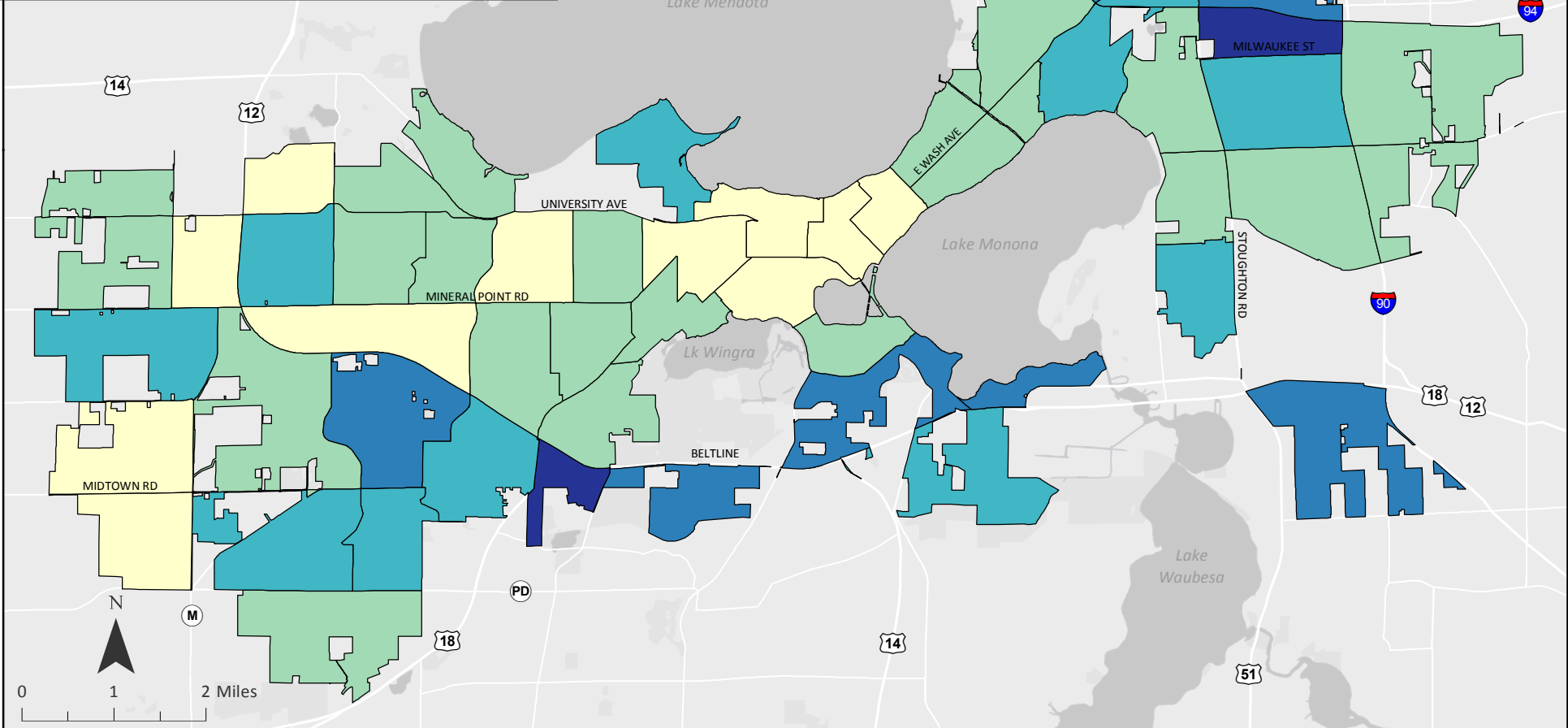

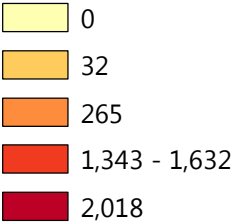

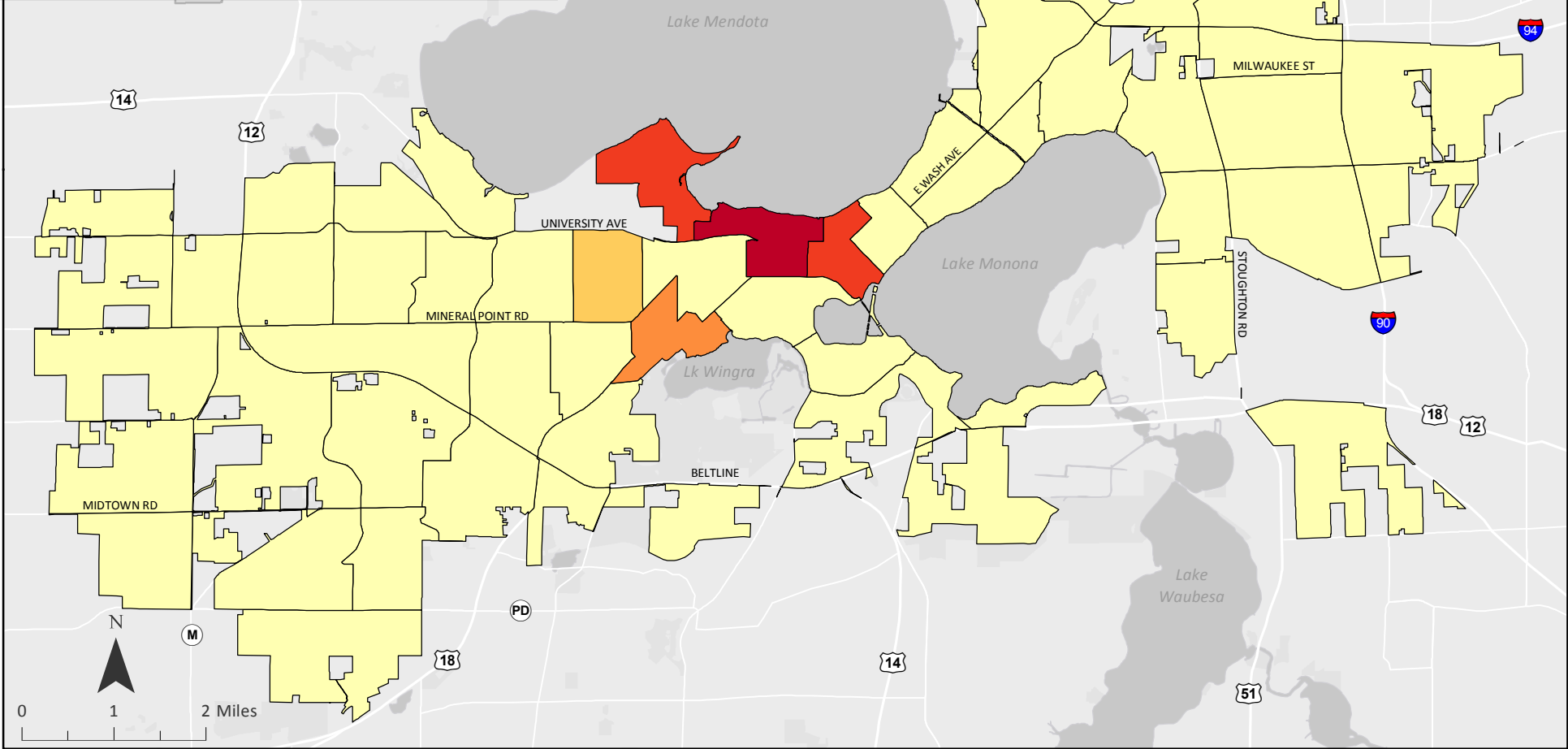

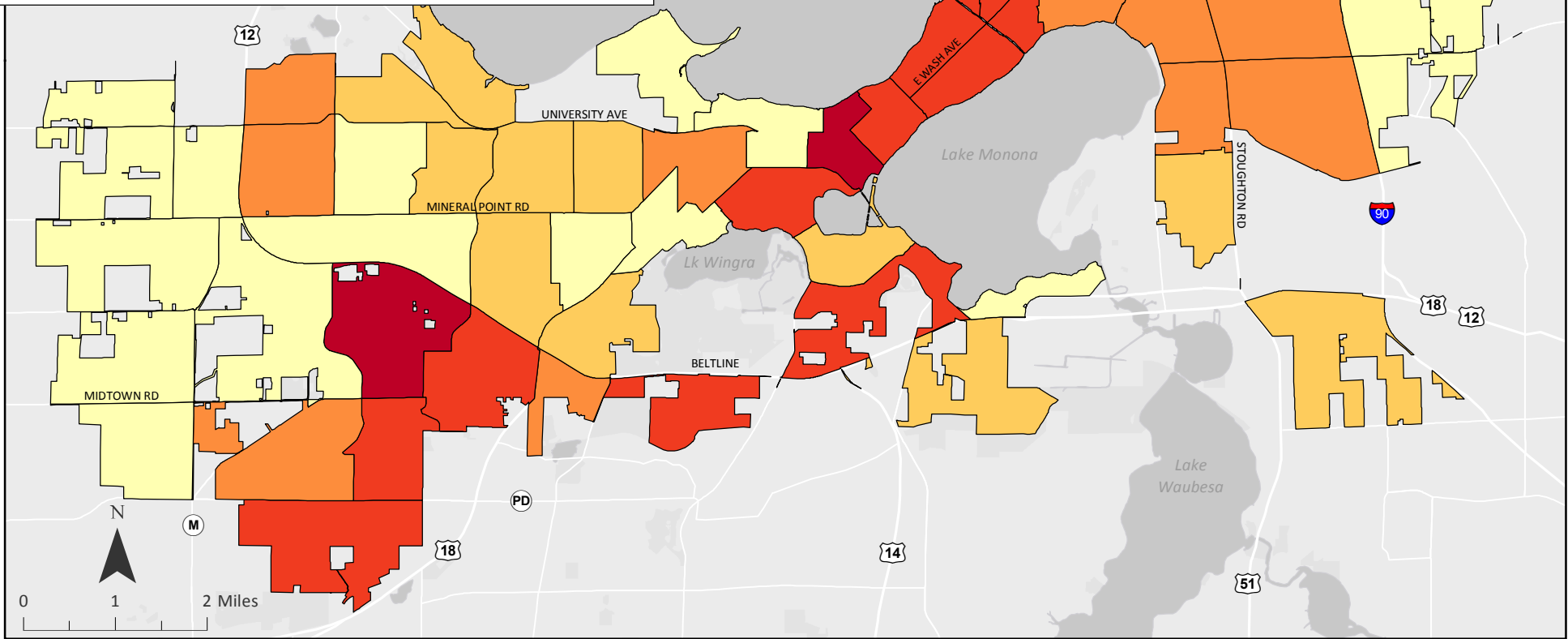

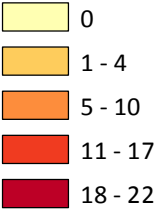

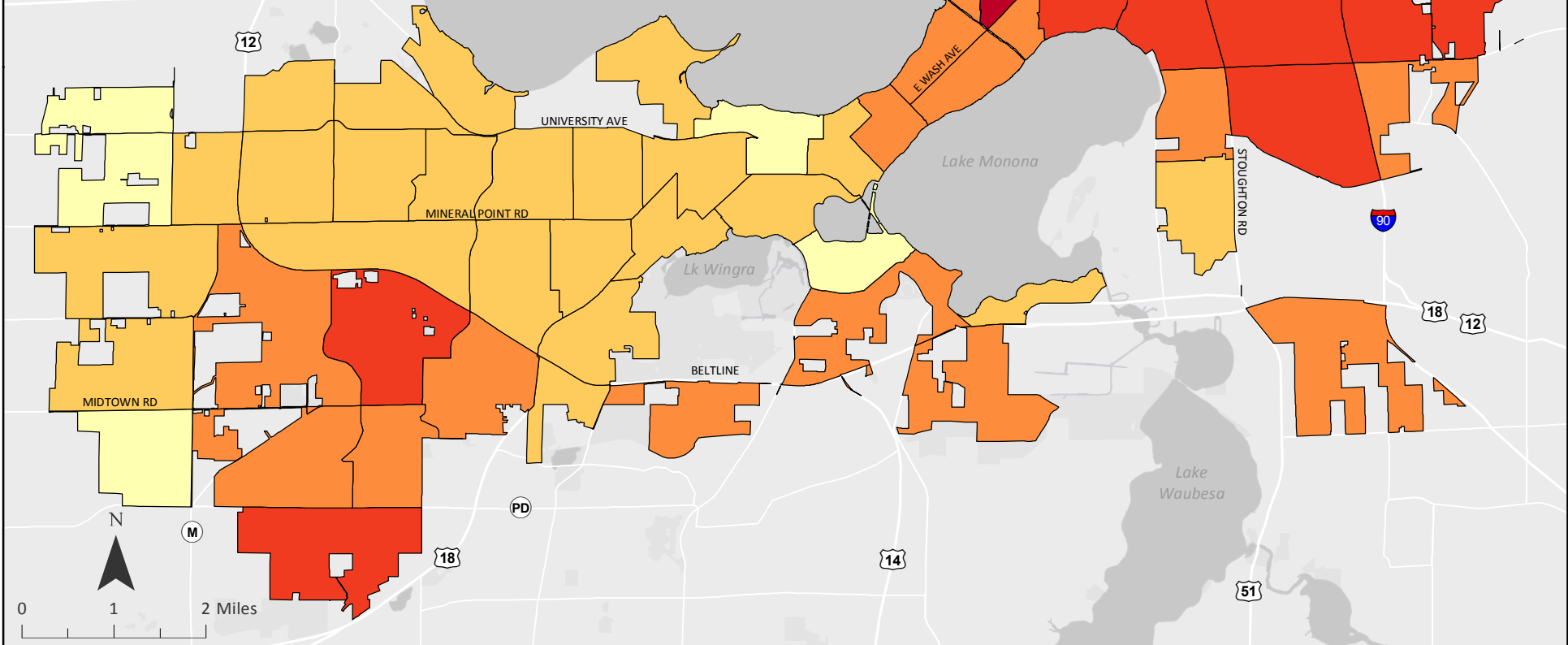

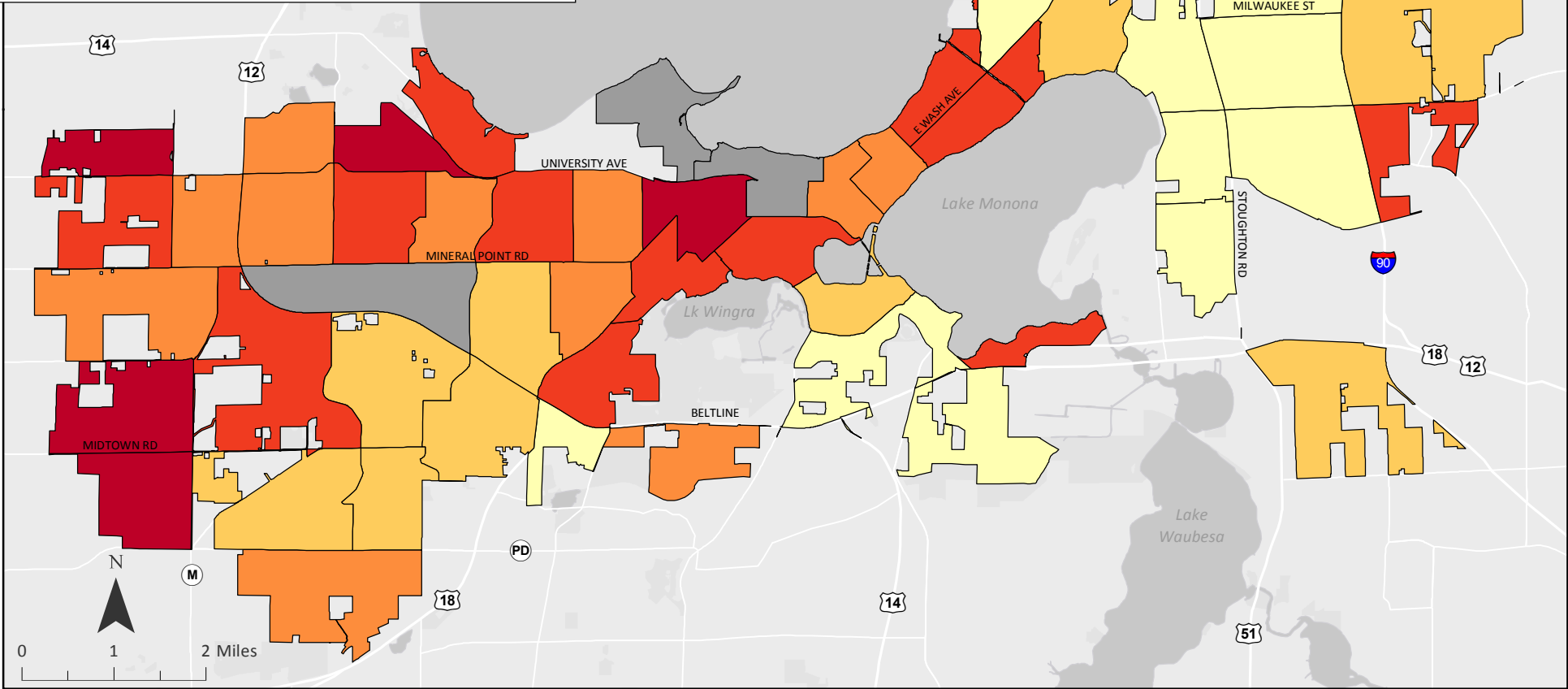

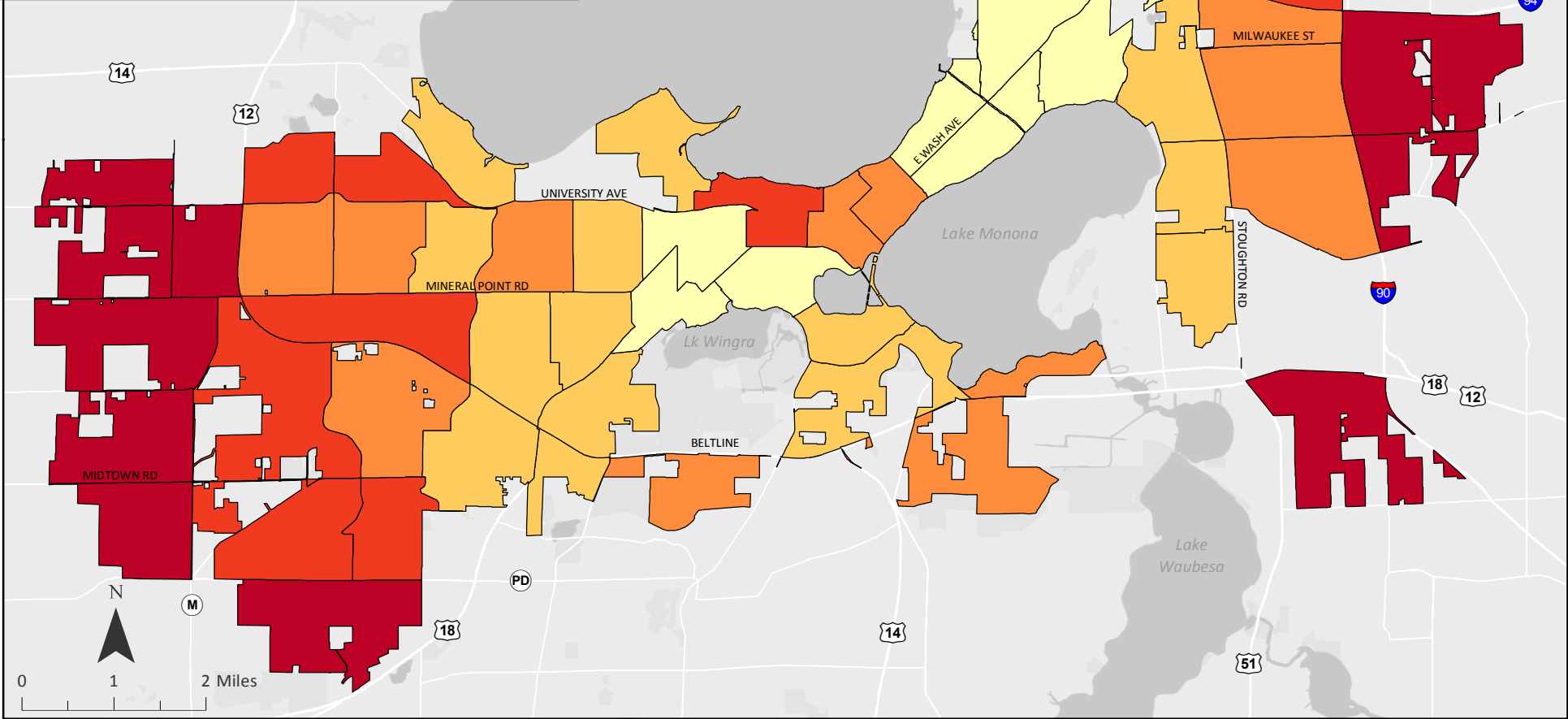

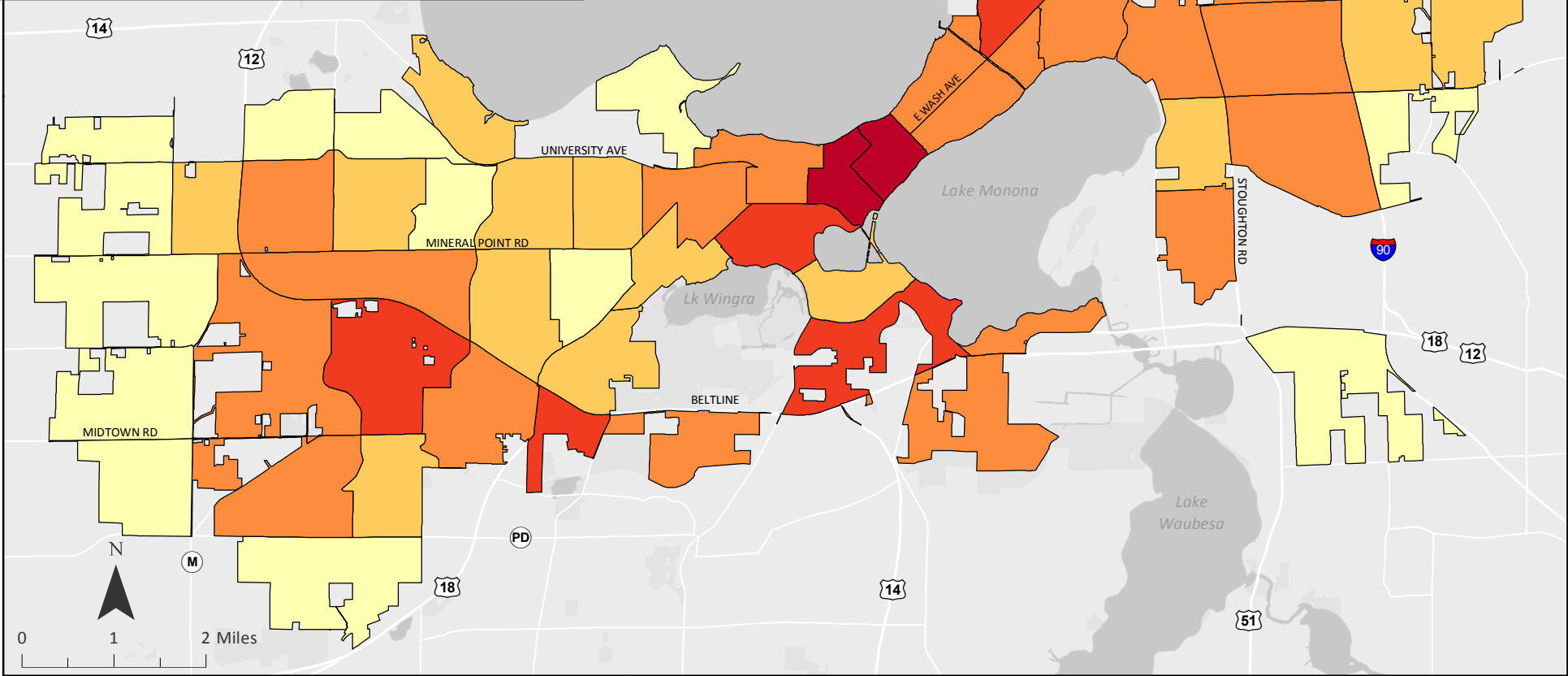

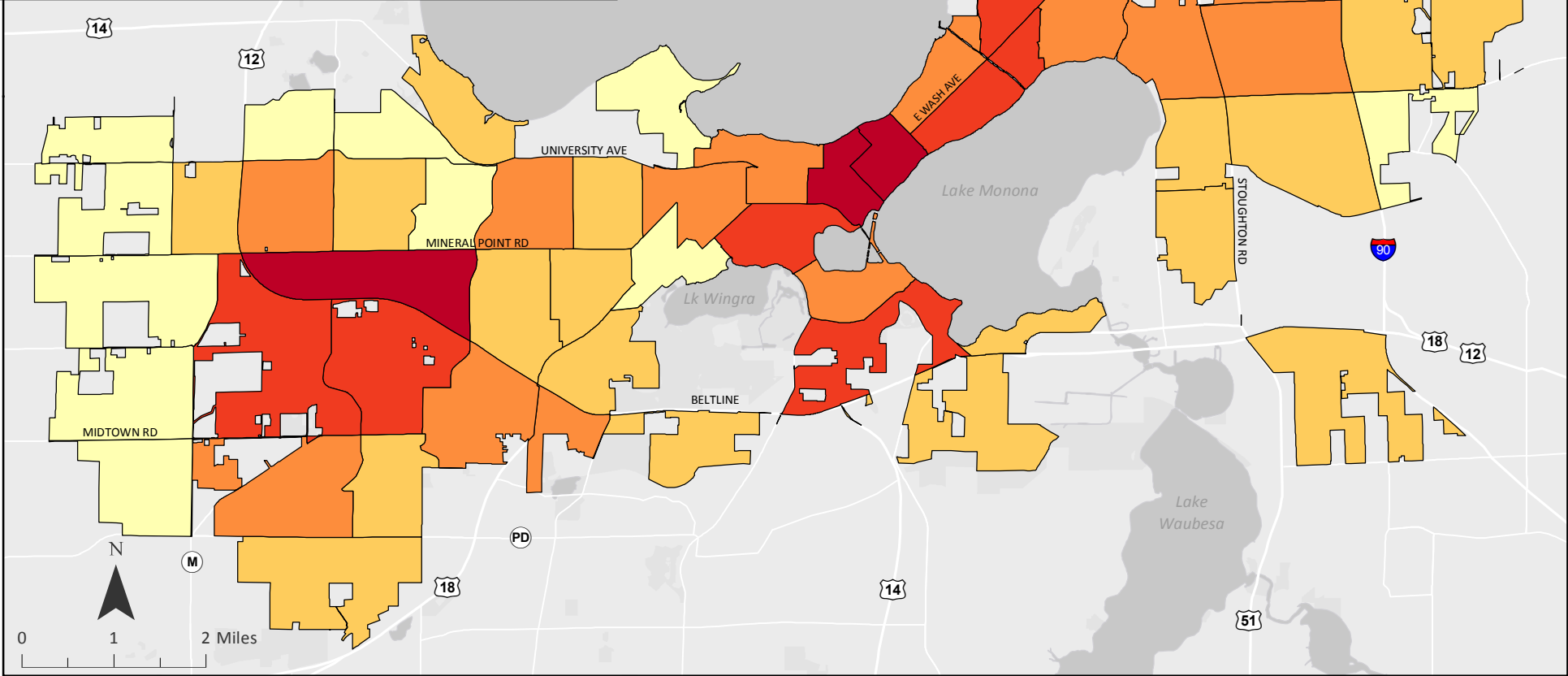

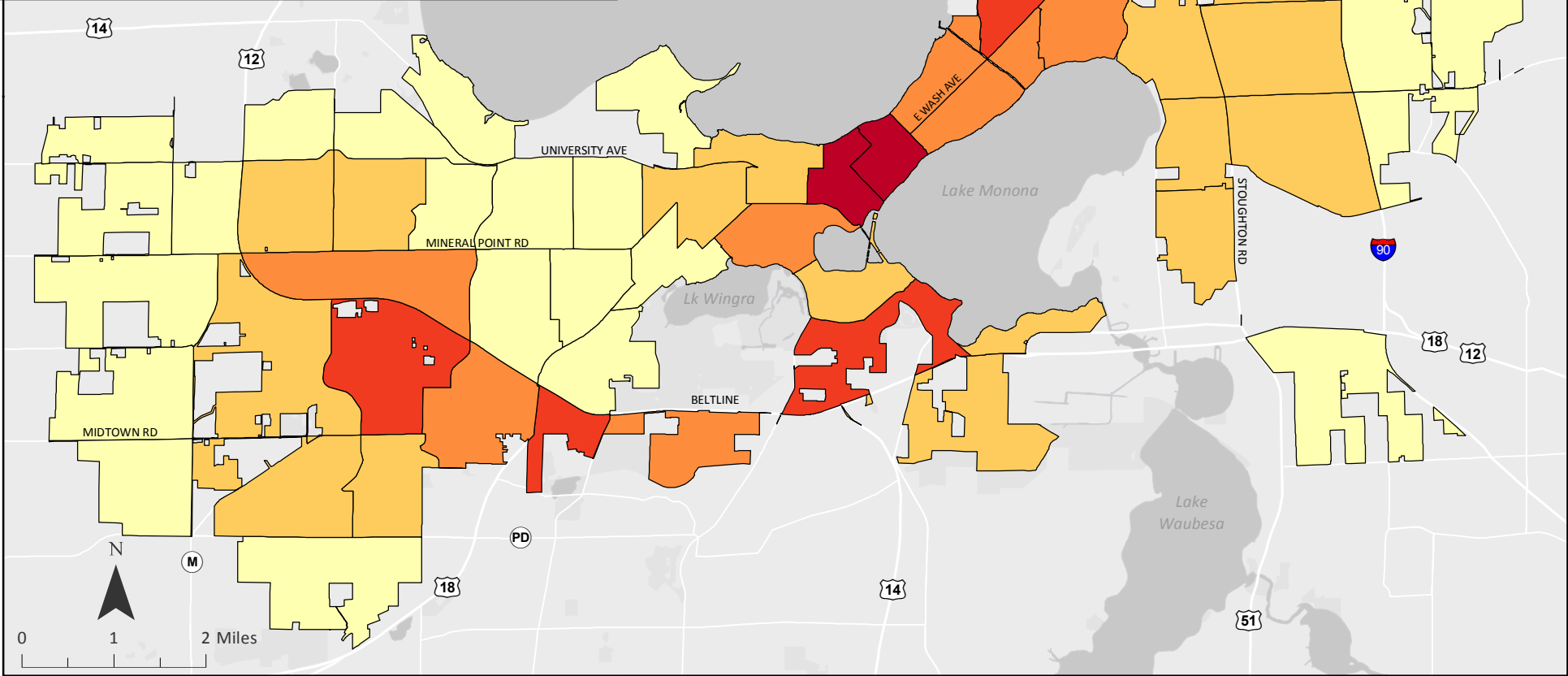

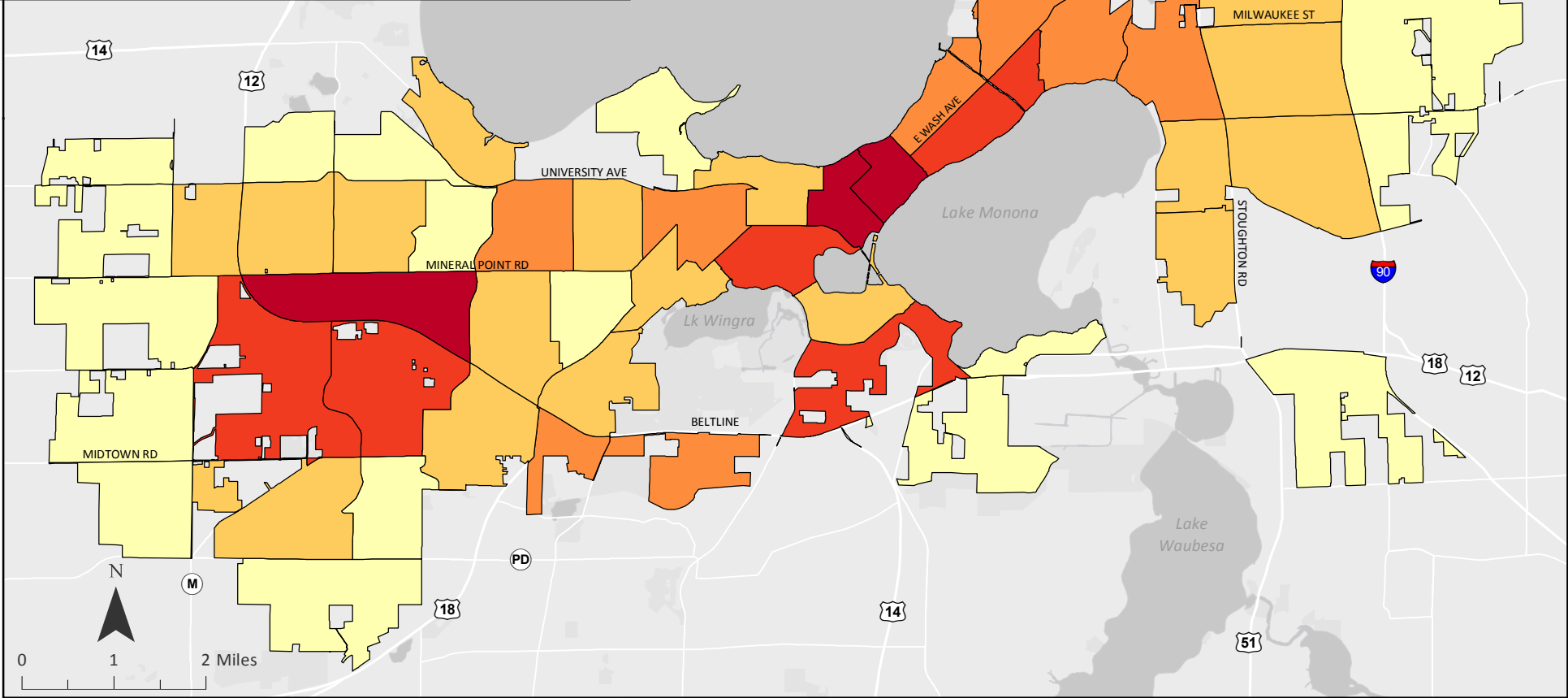

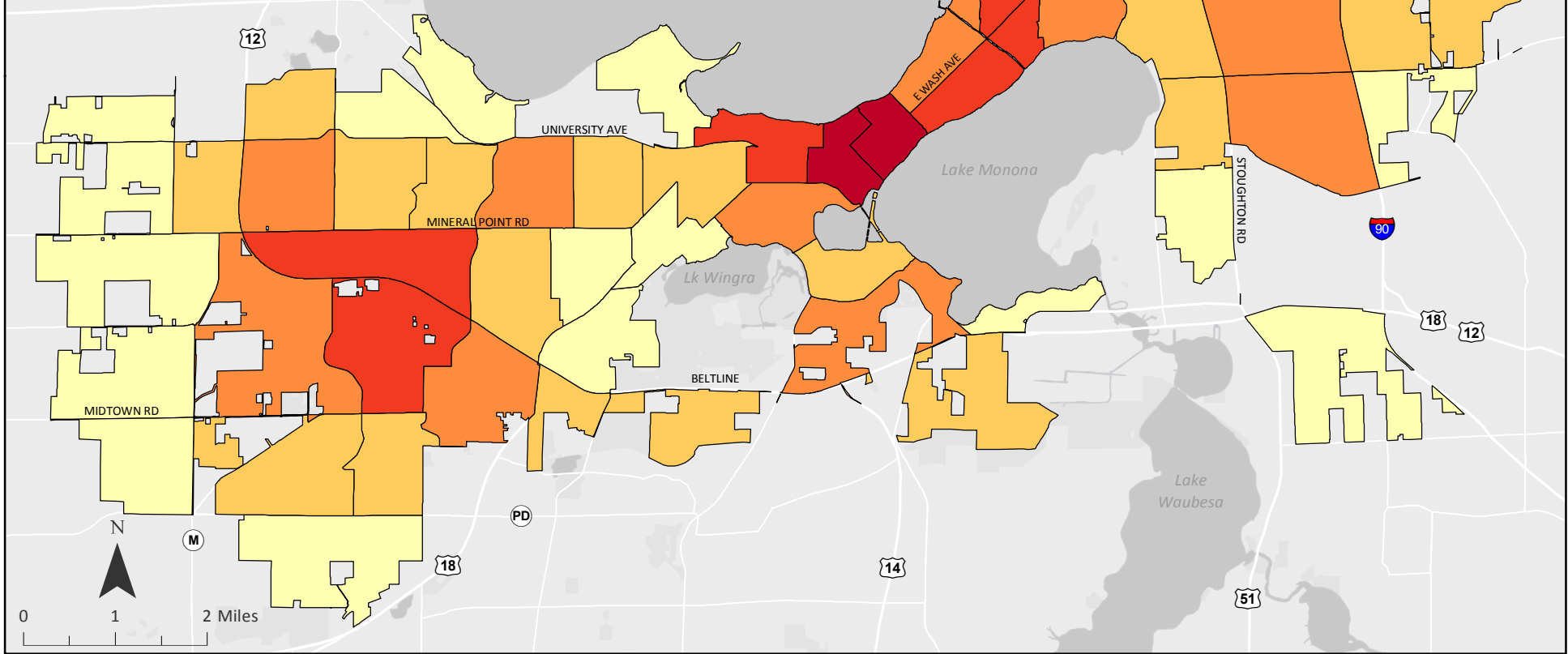

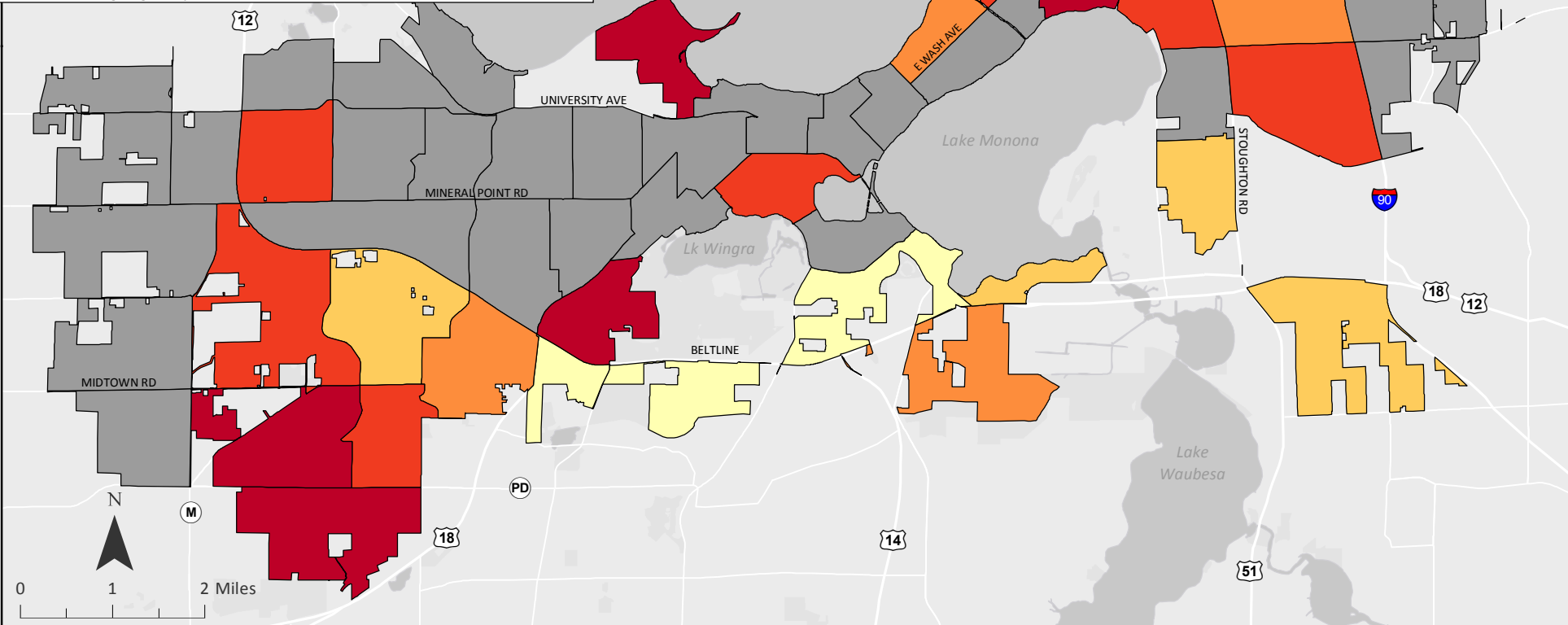

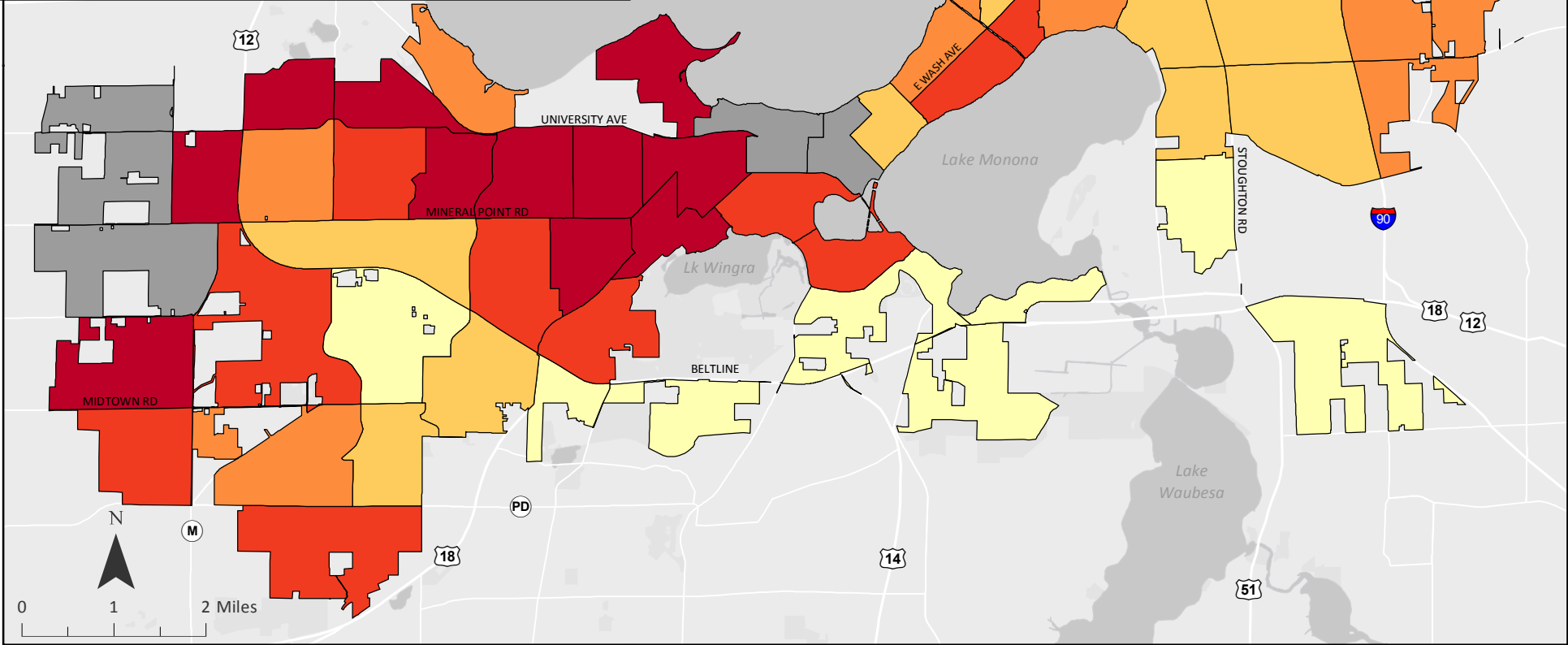

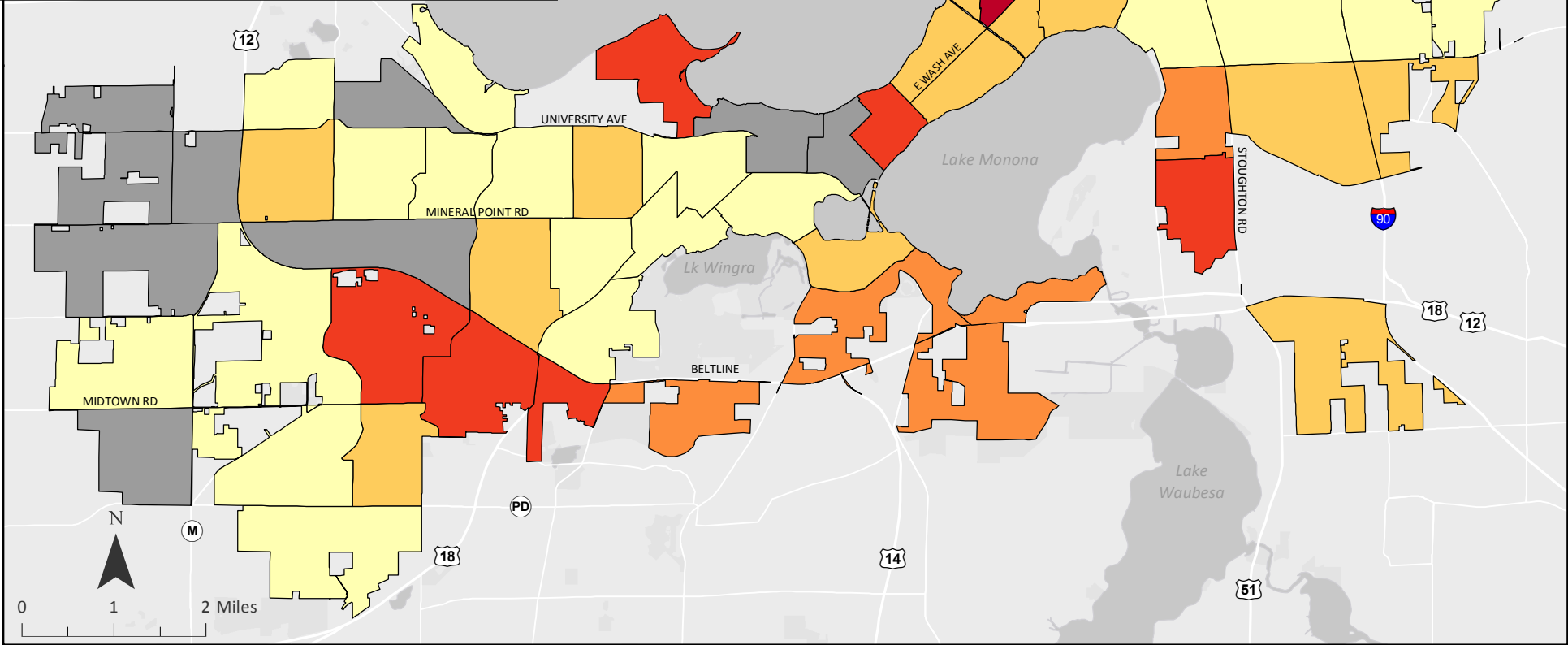

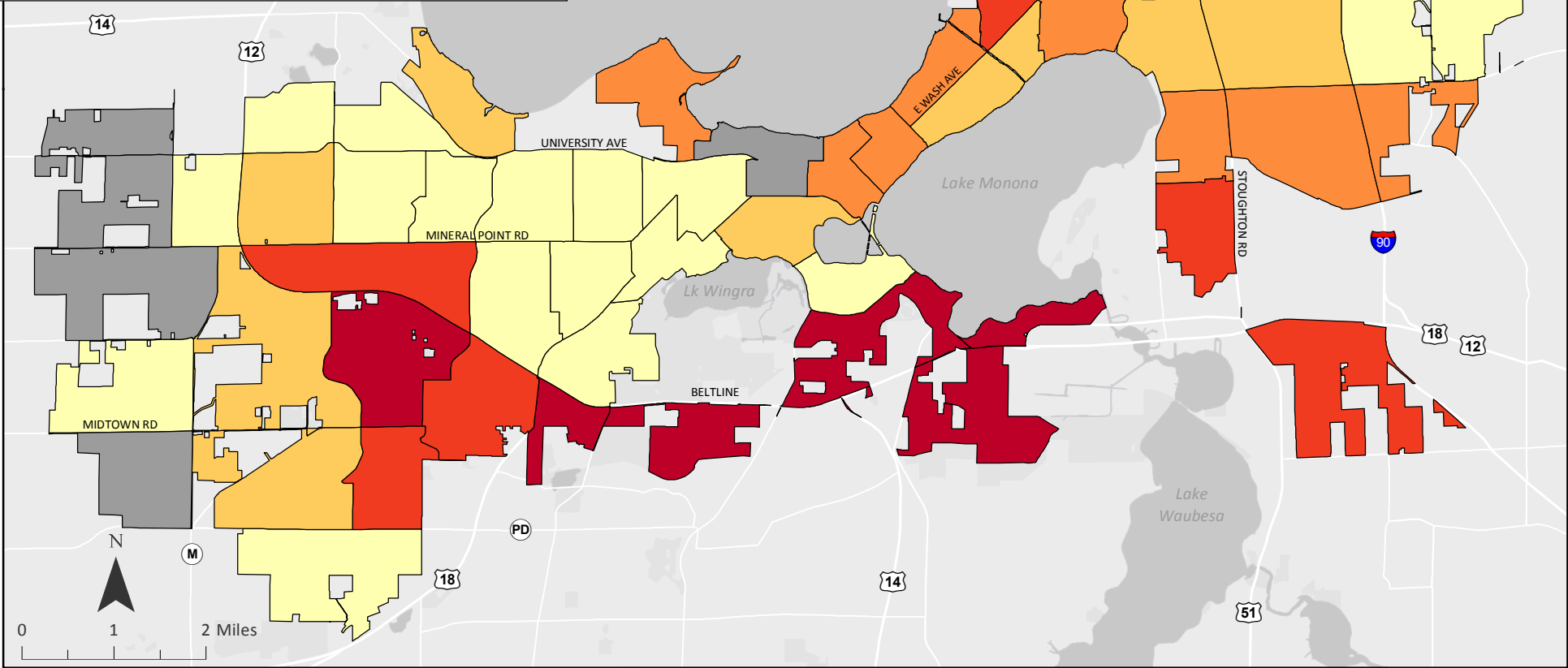

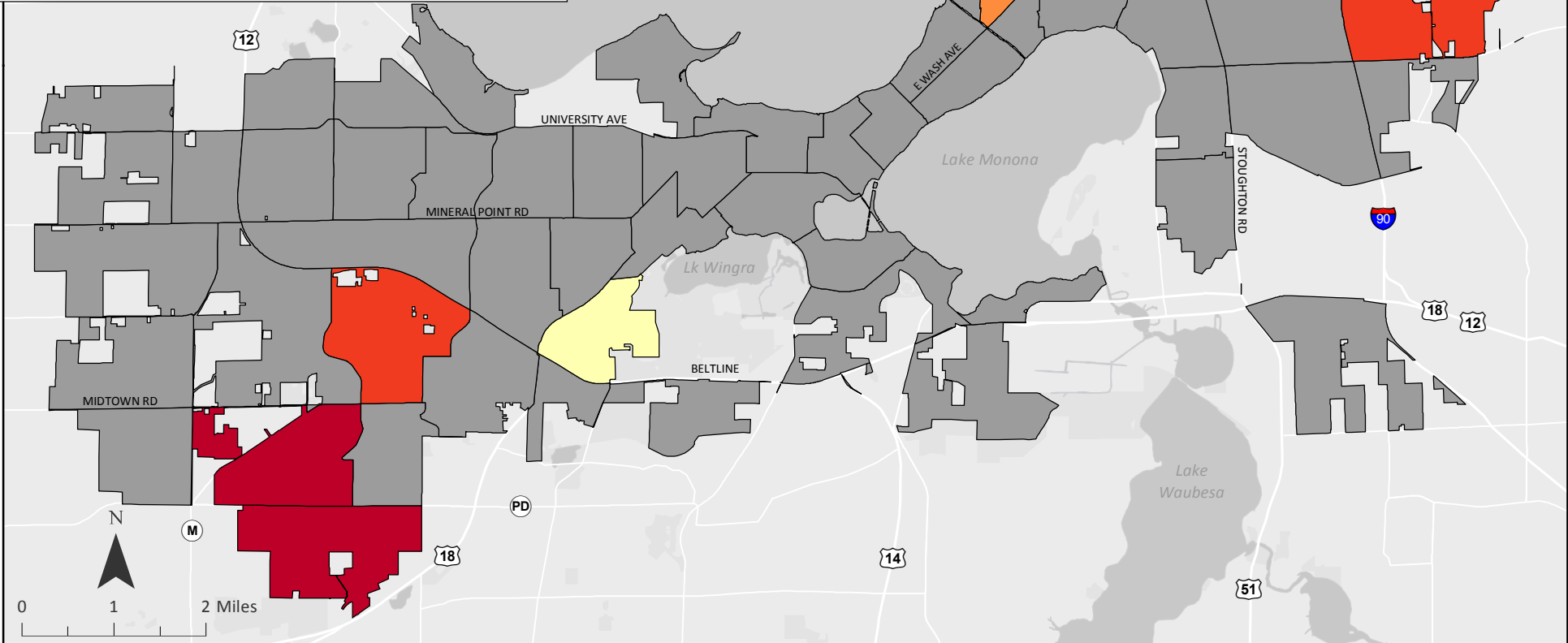

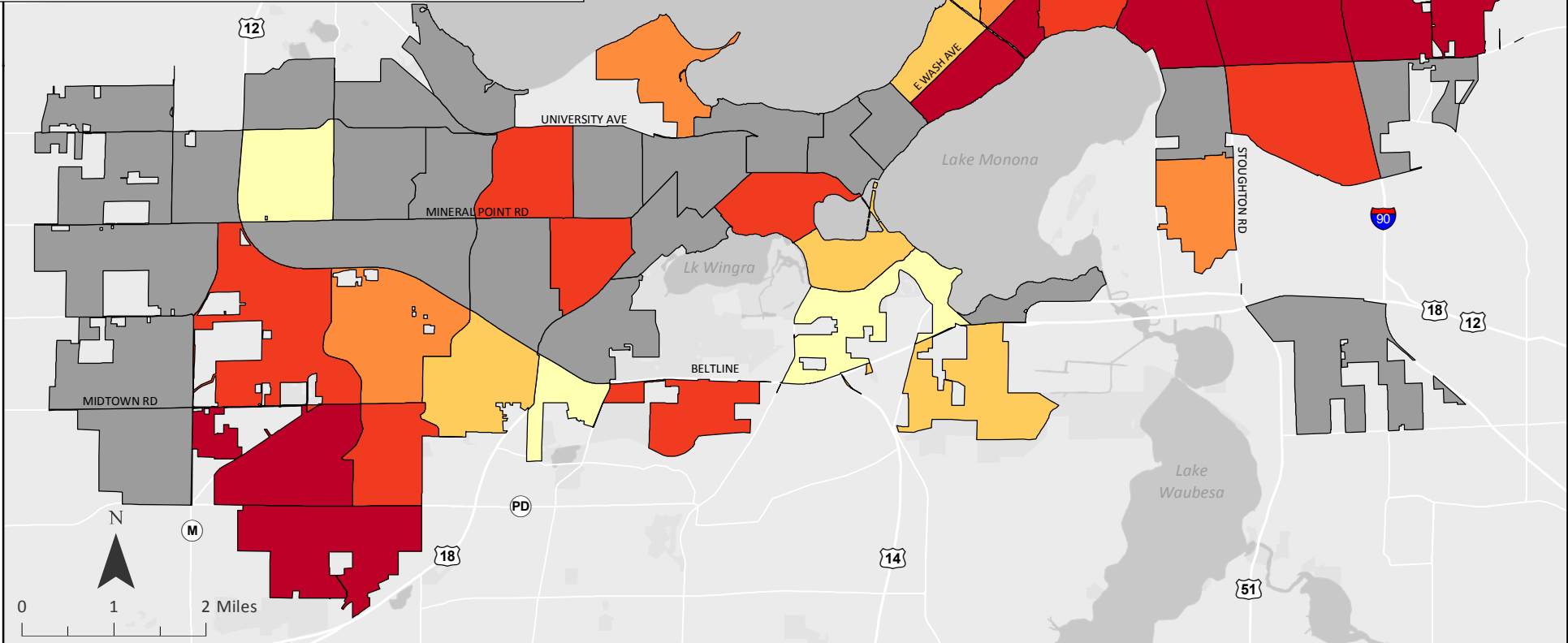

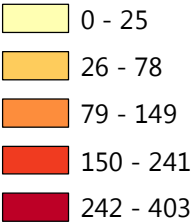

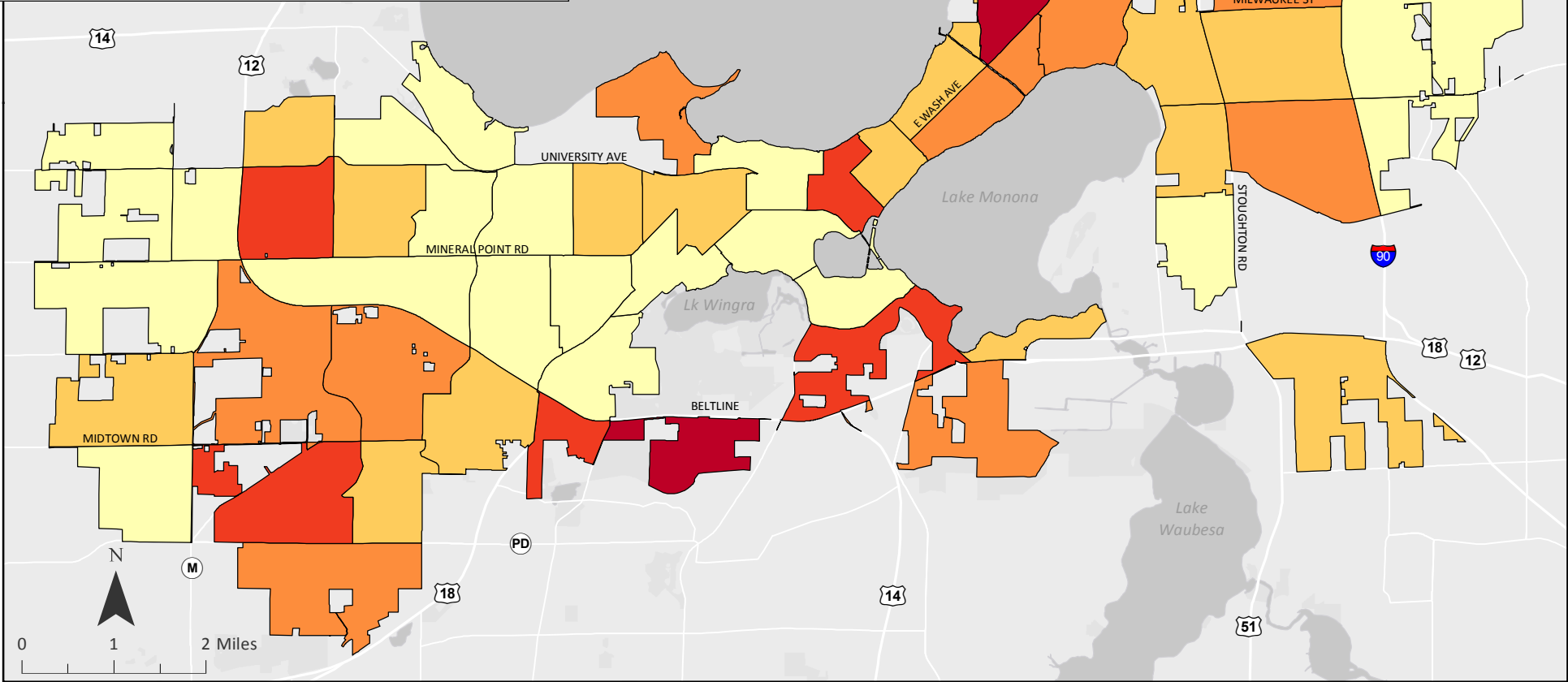

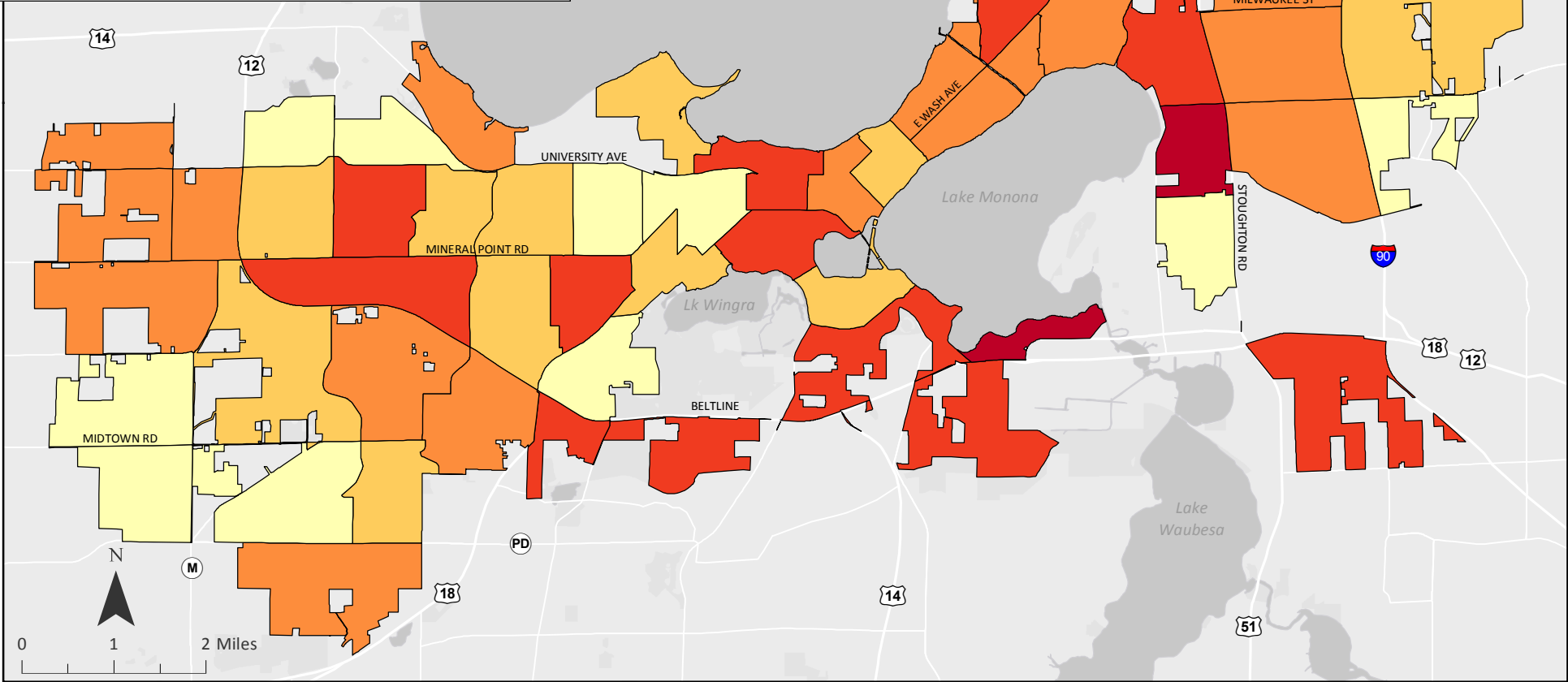

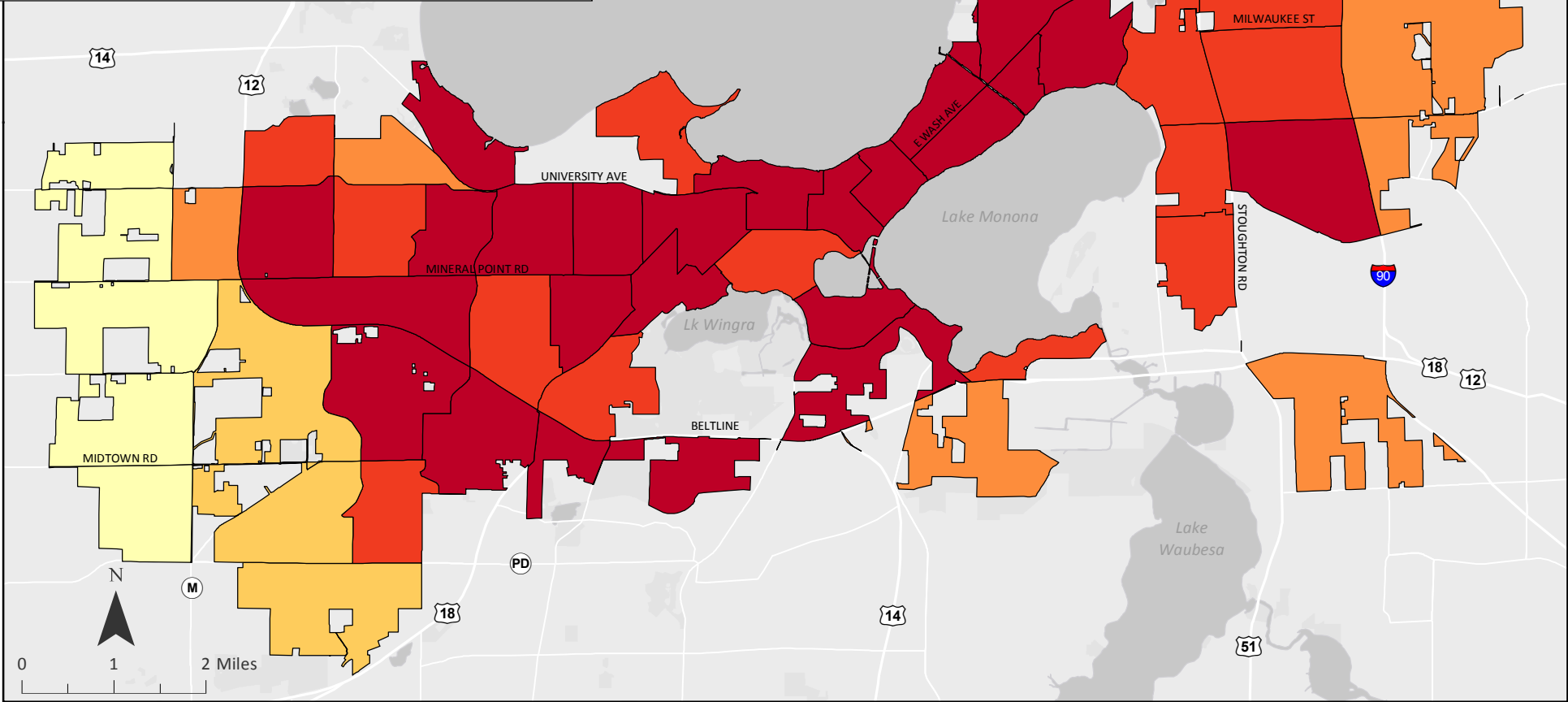

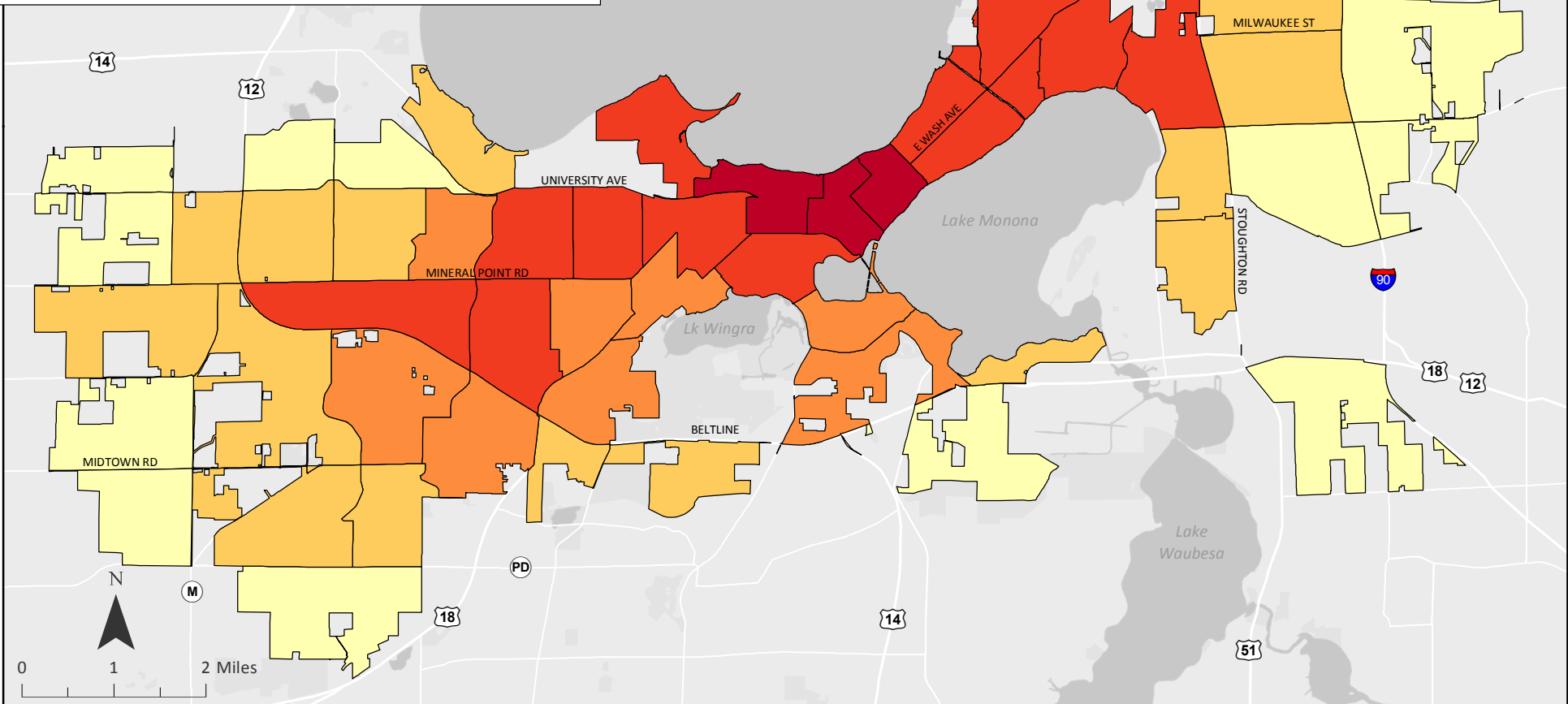

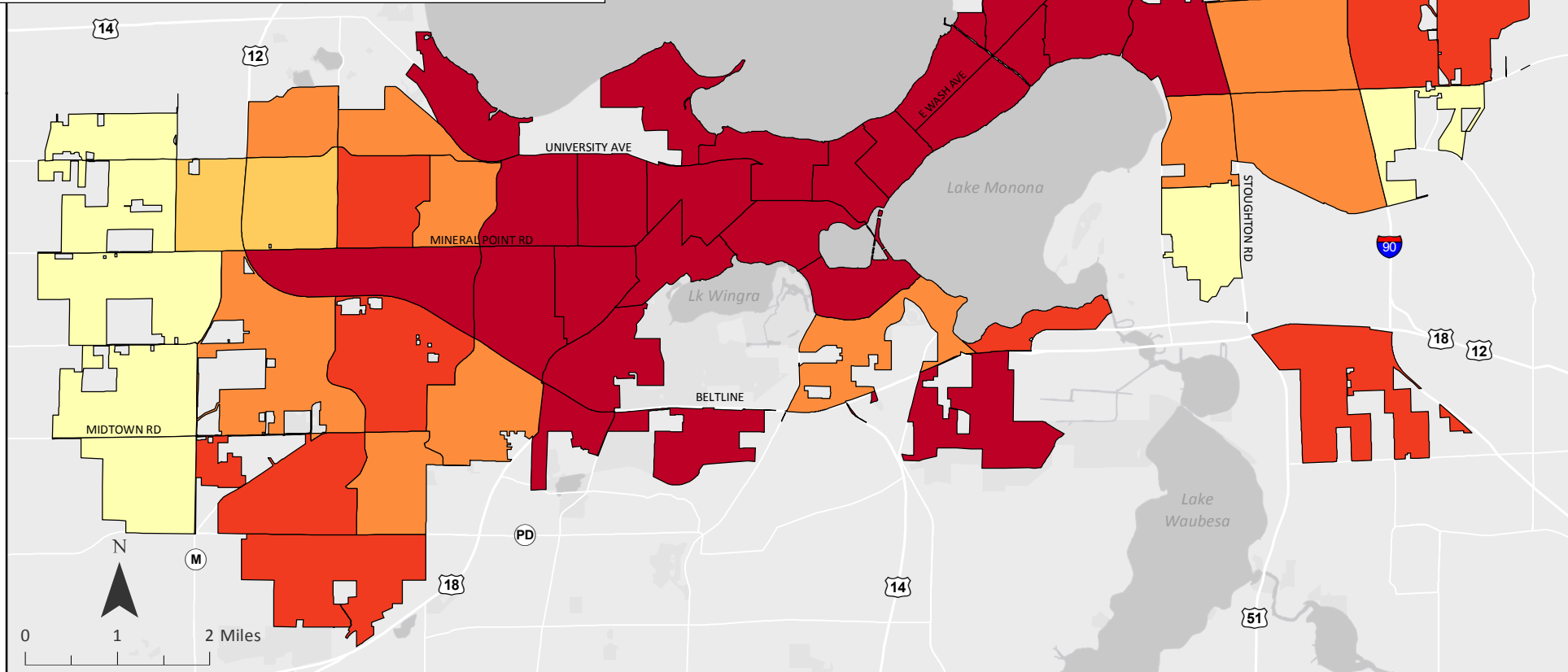




Bike Network Access*

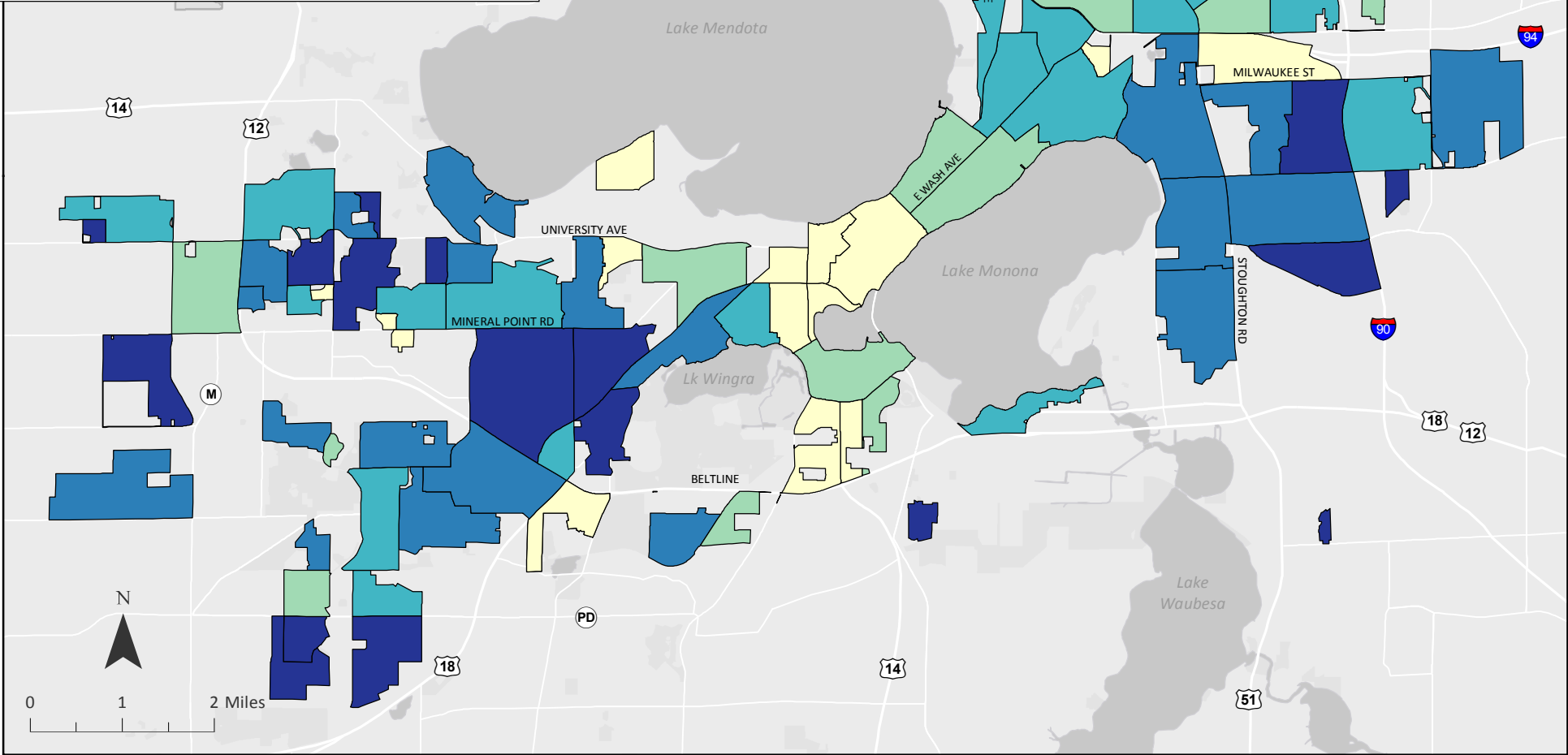

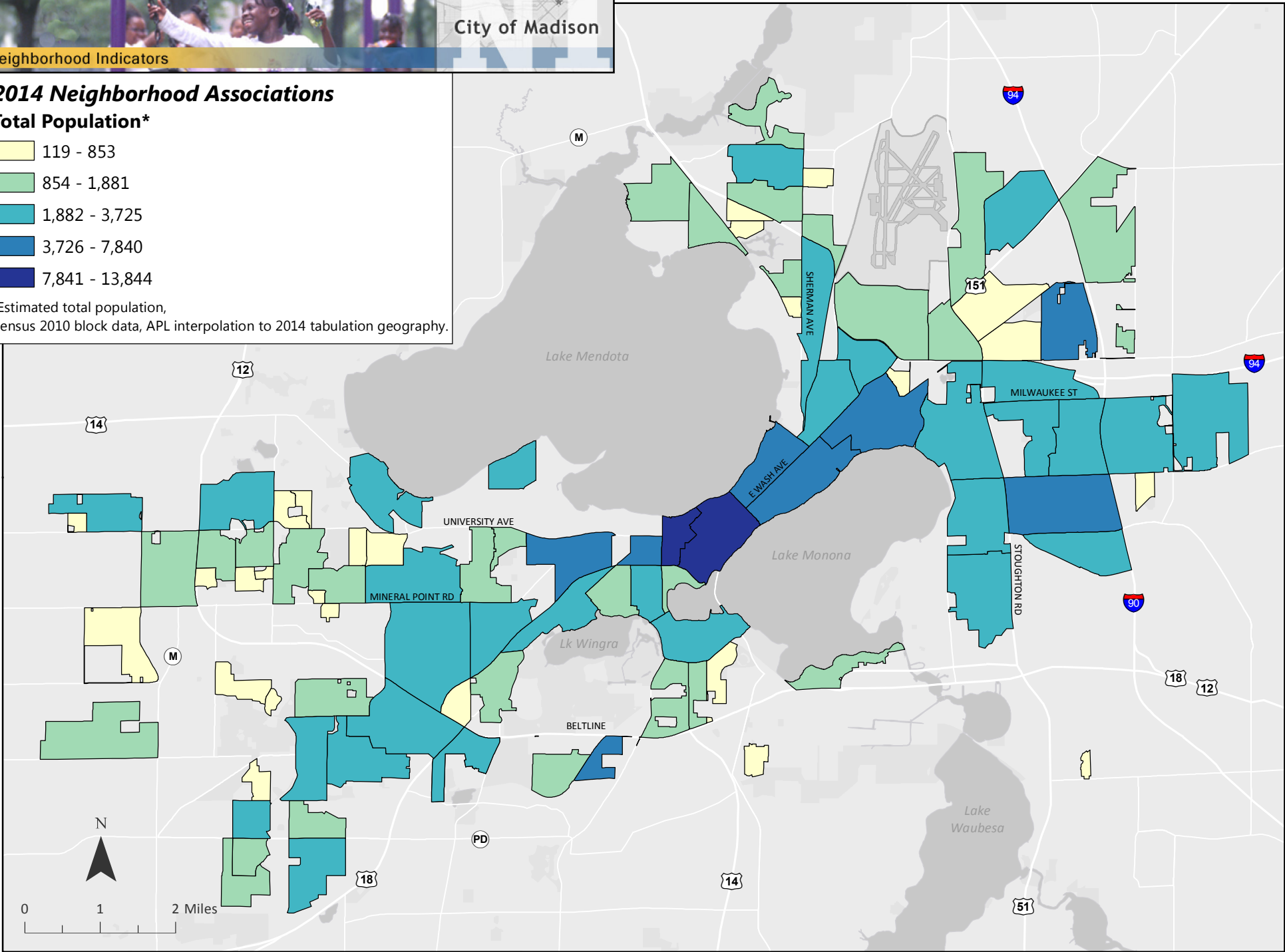

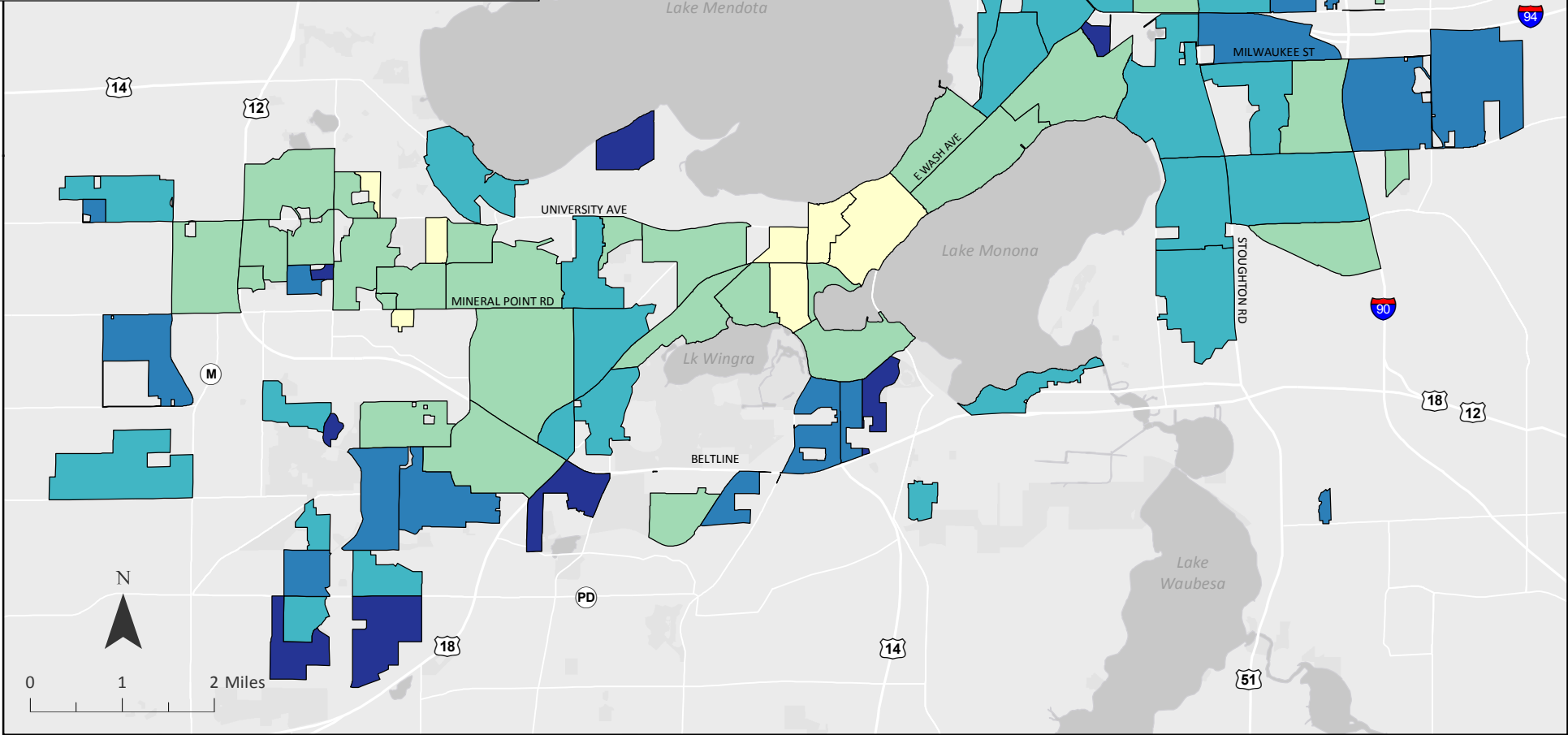

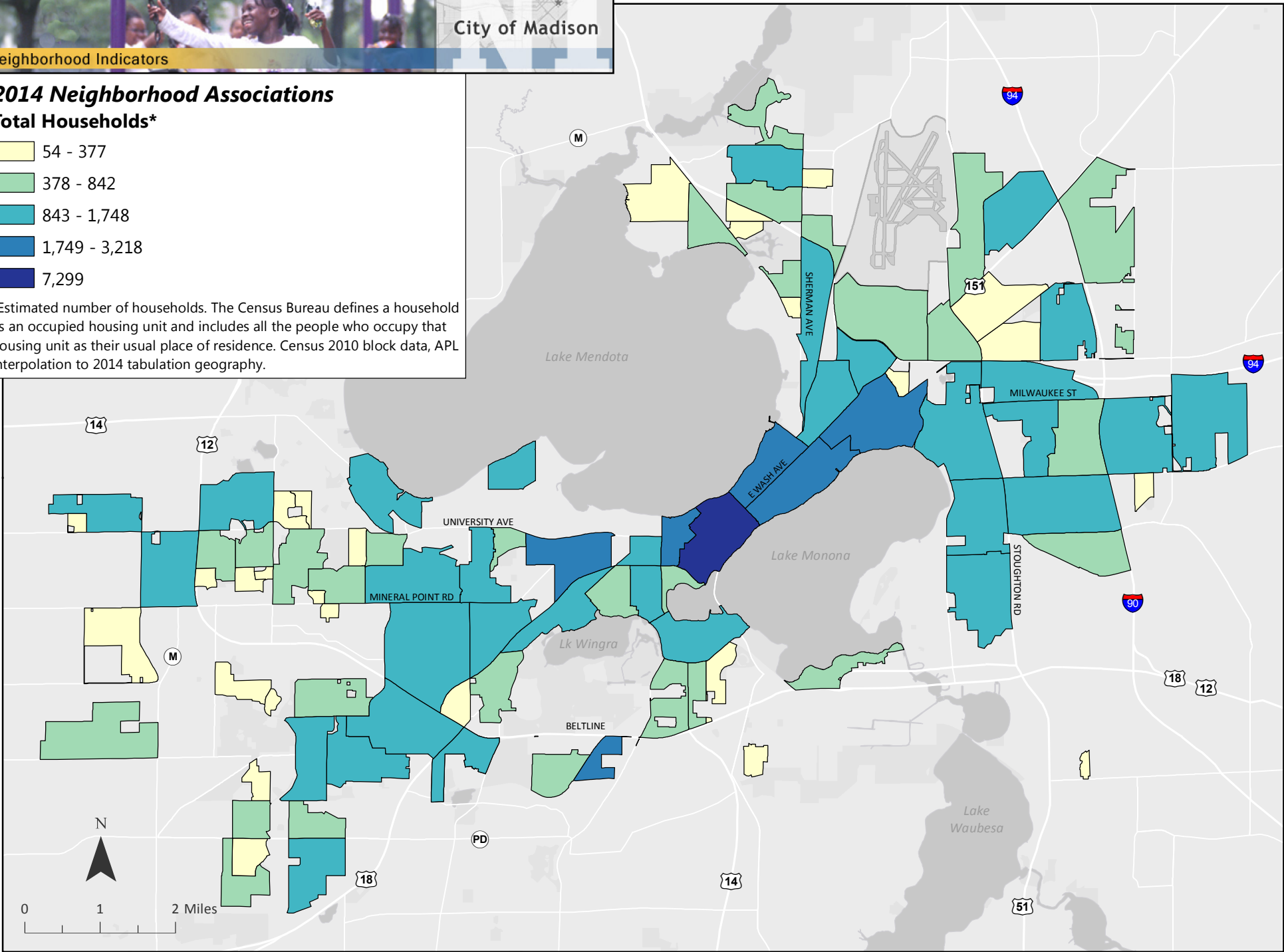

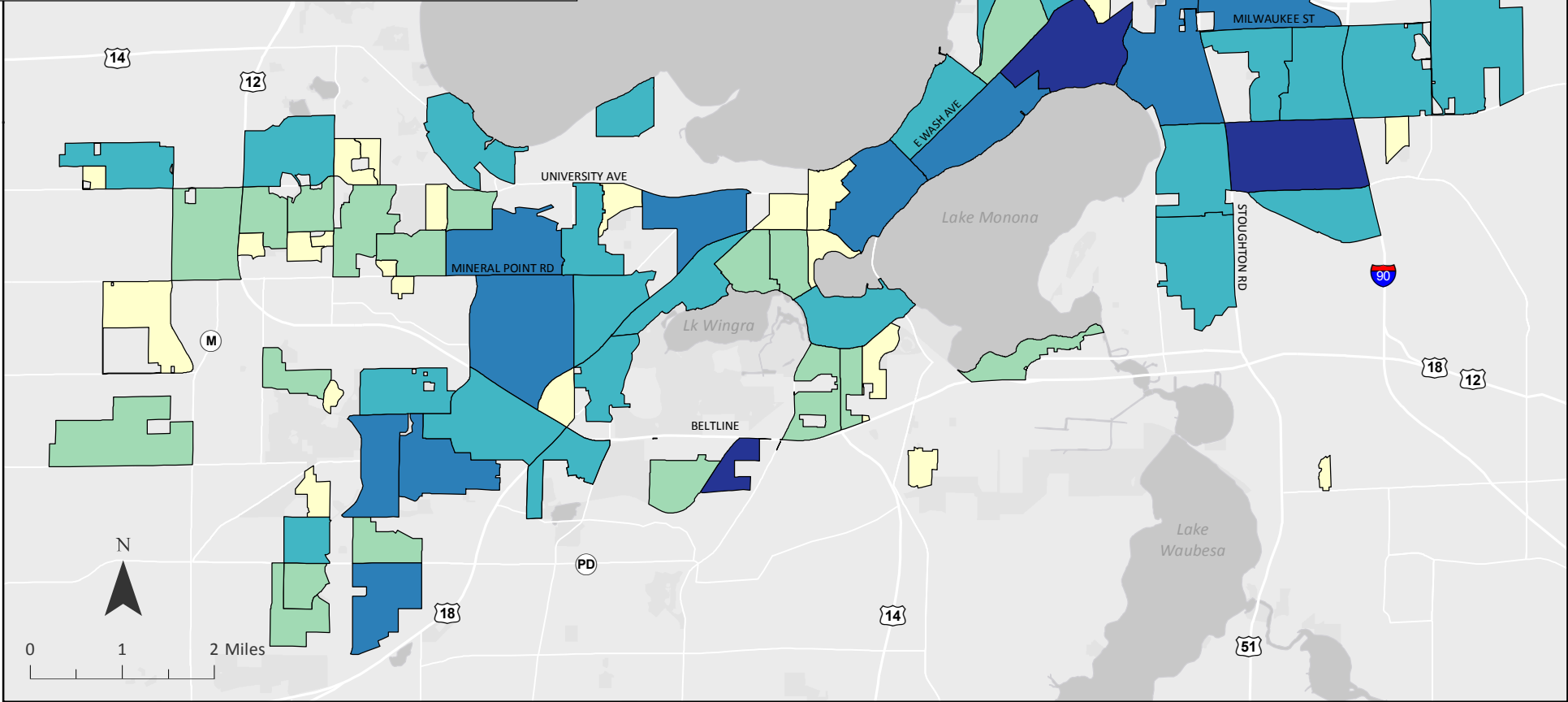

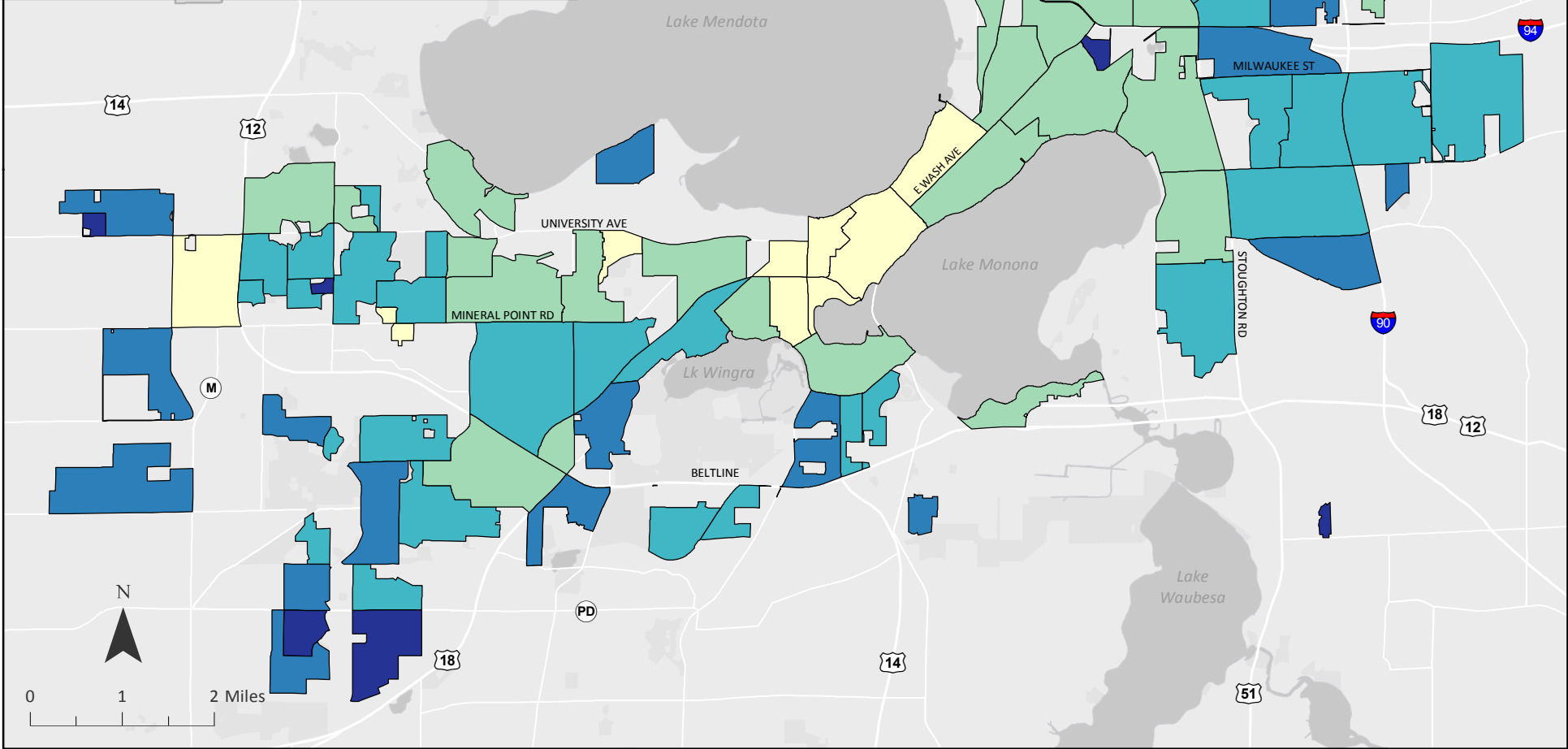

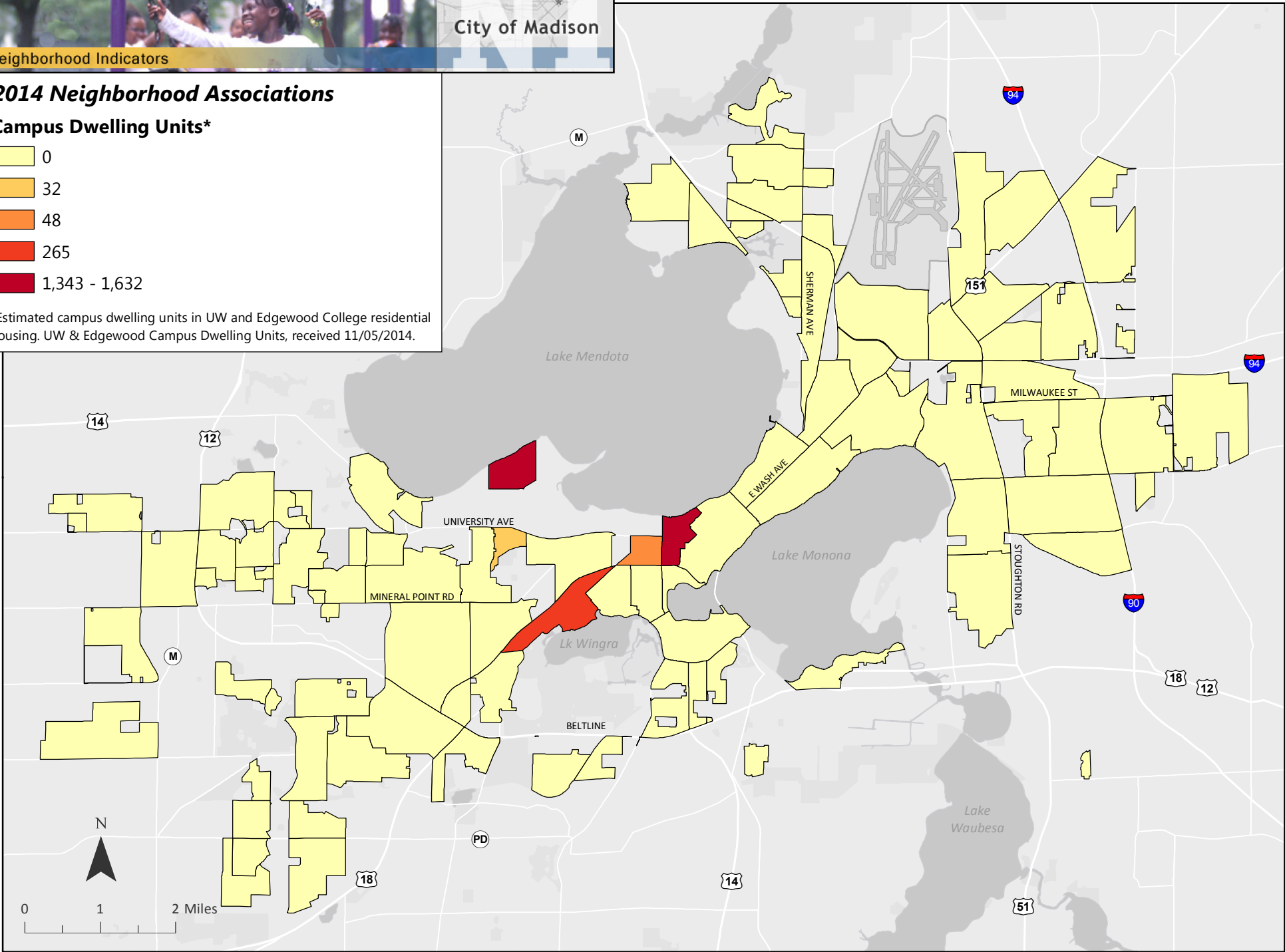

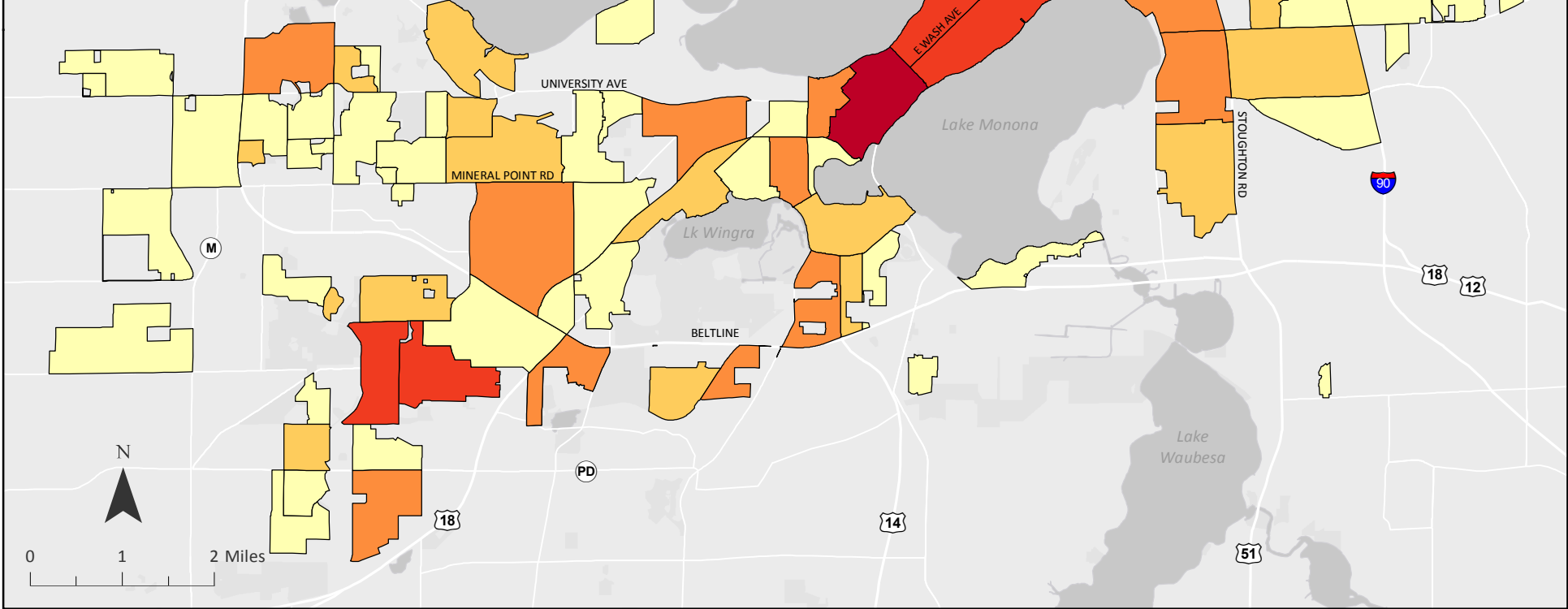

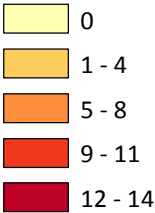

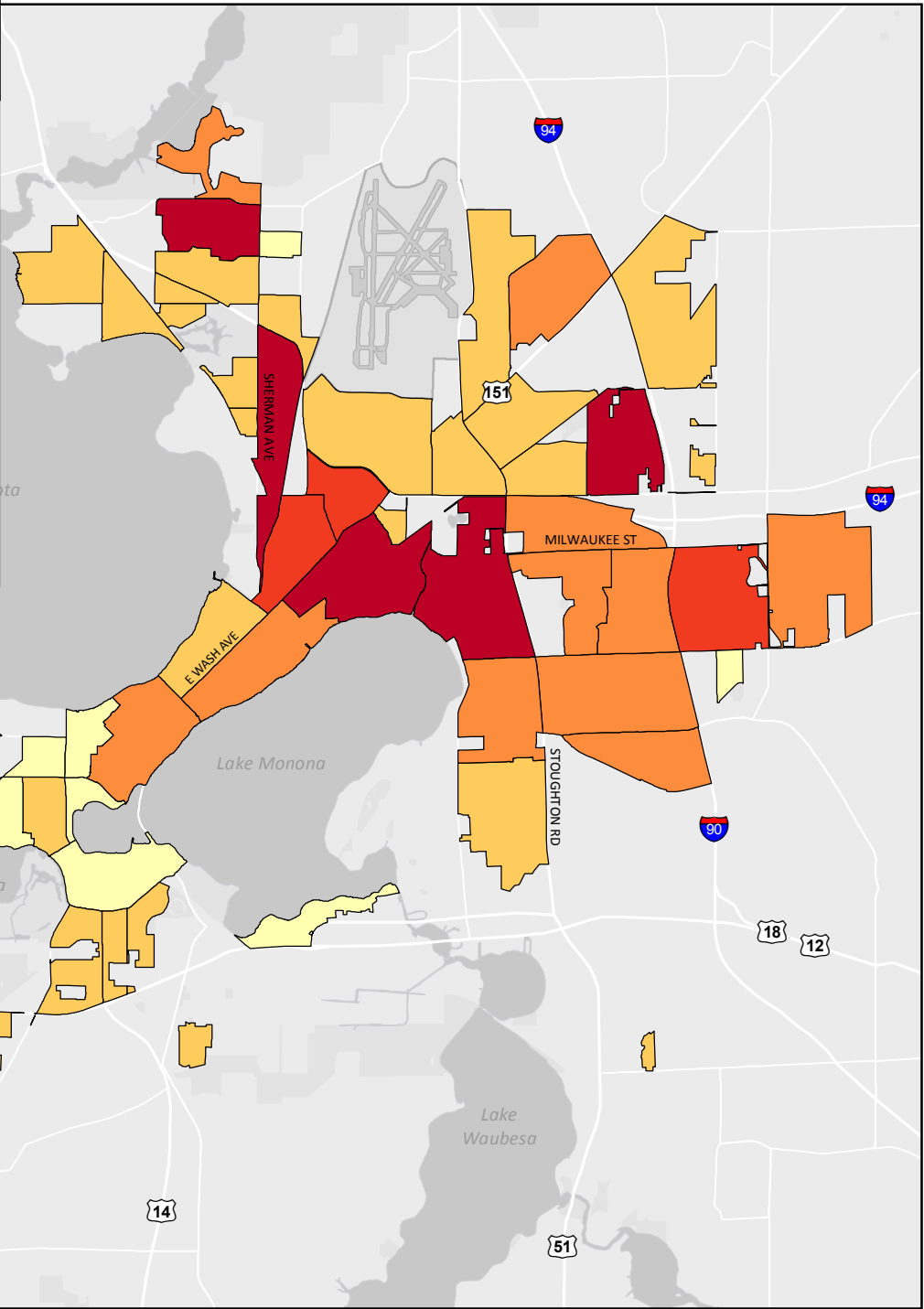

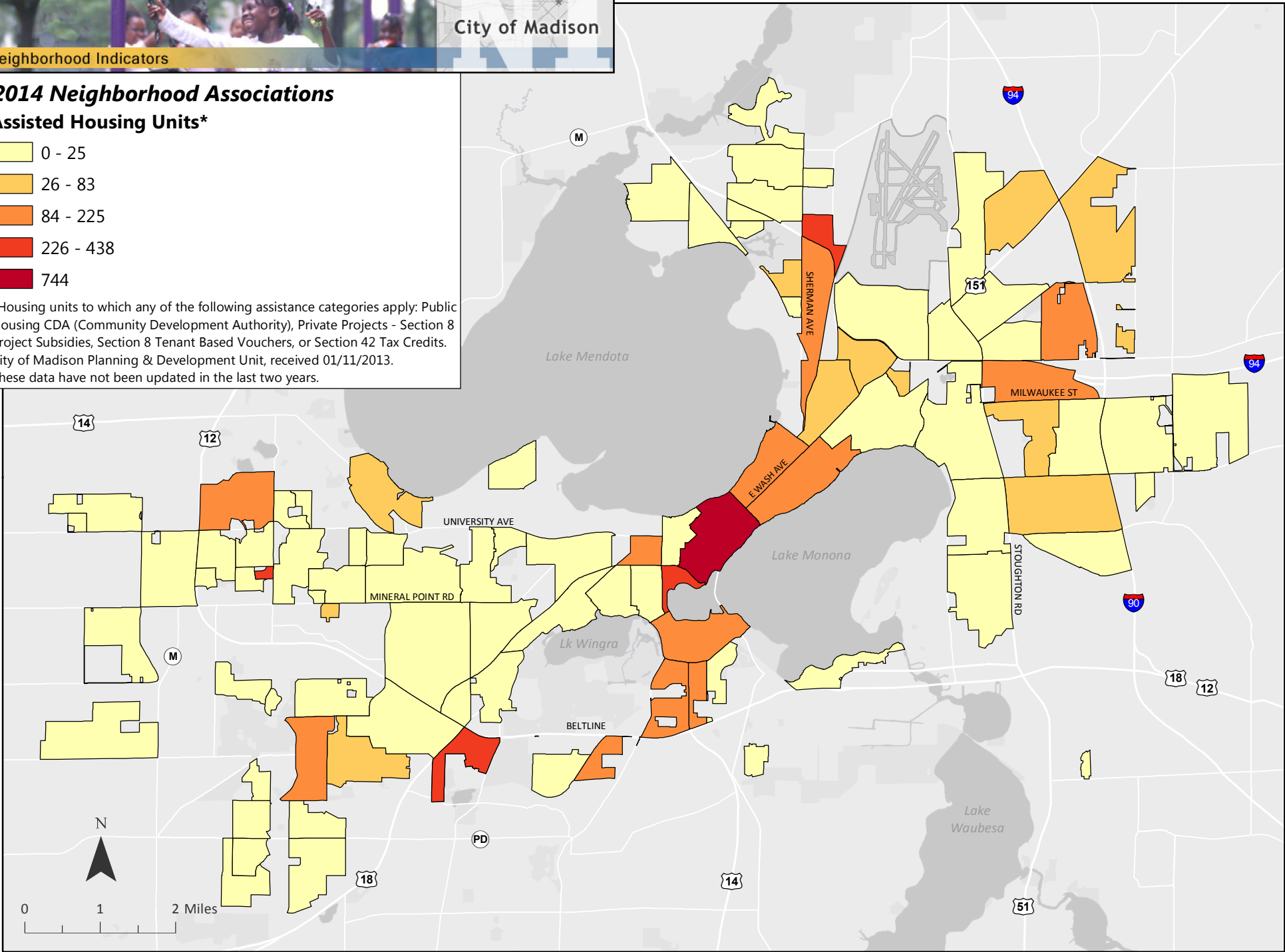

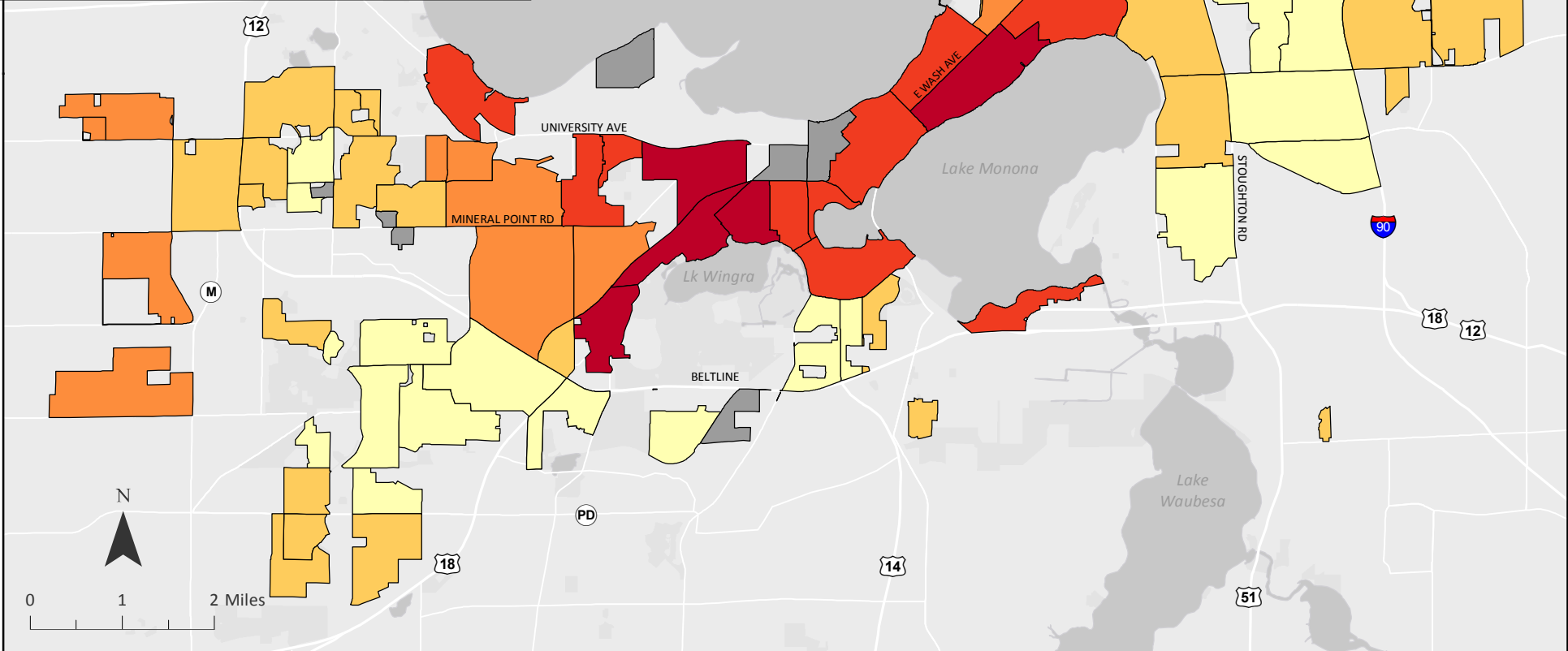

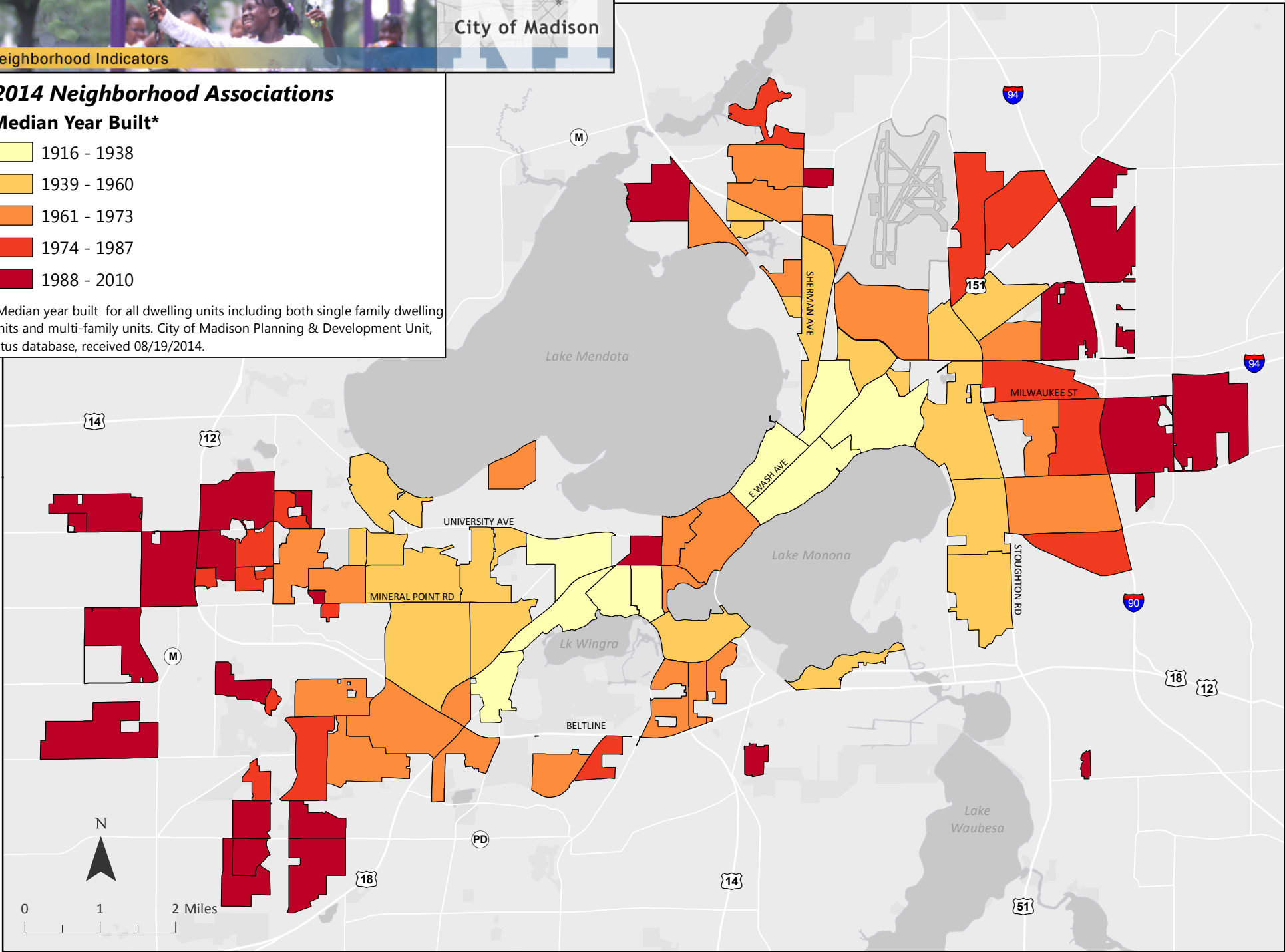

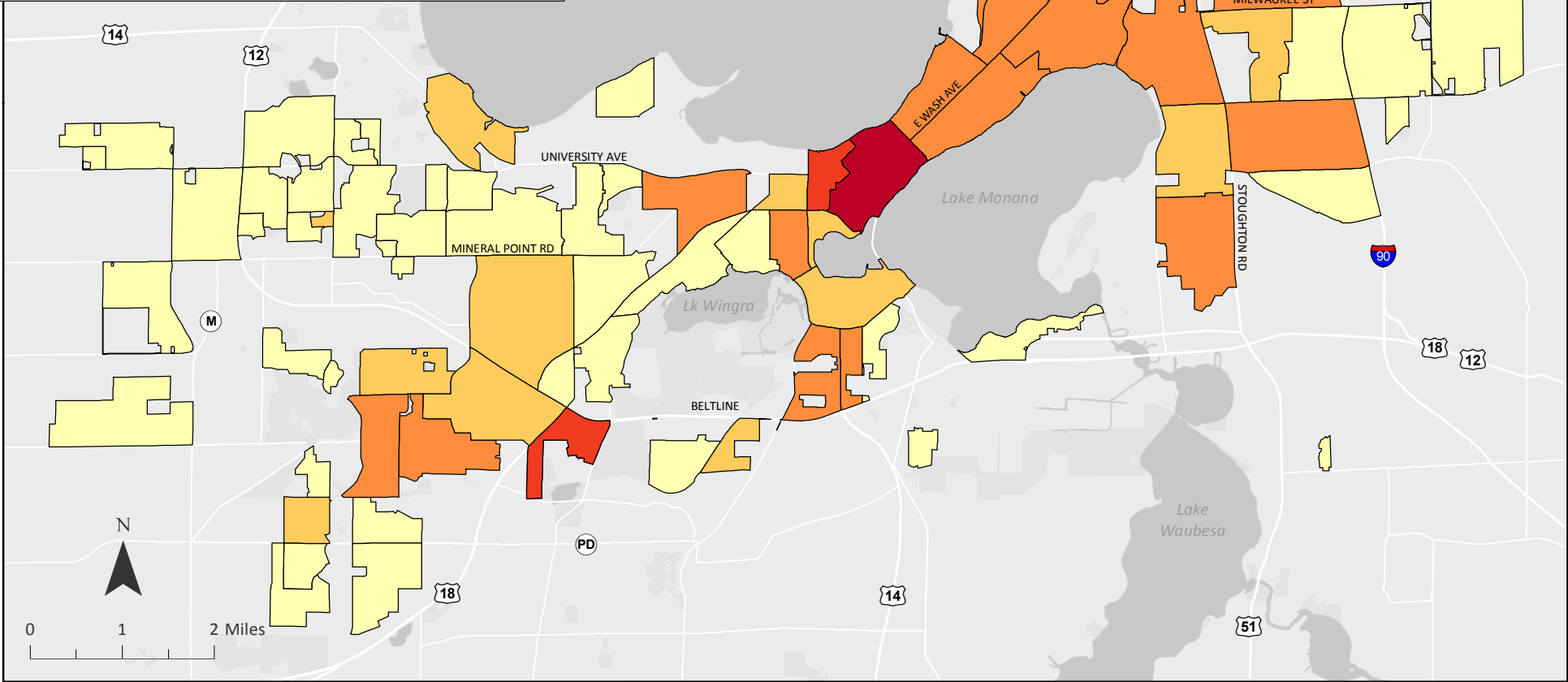

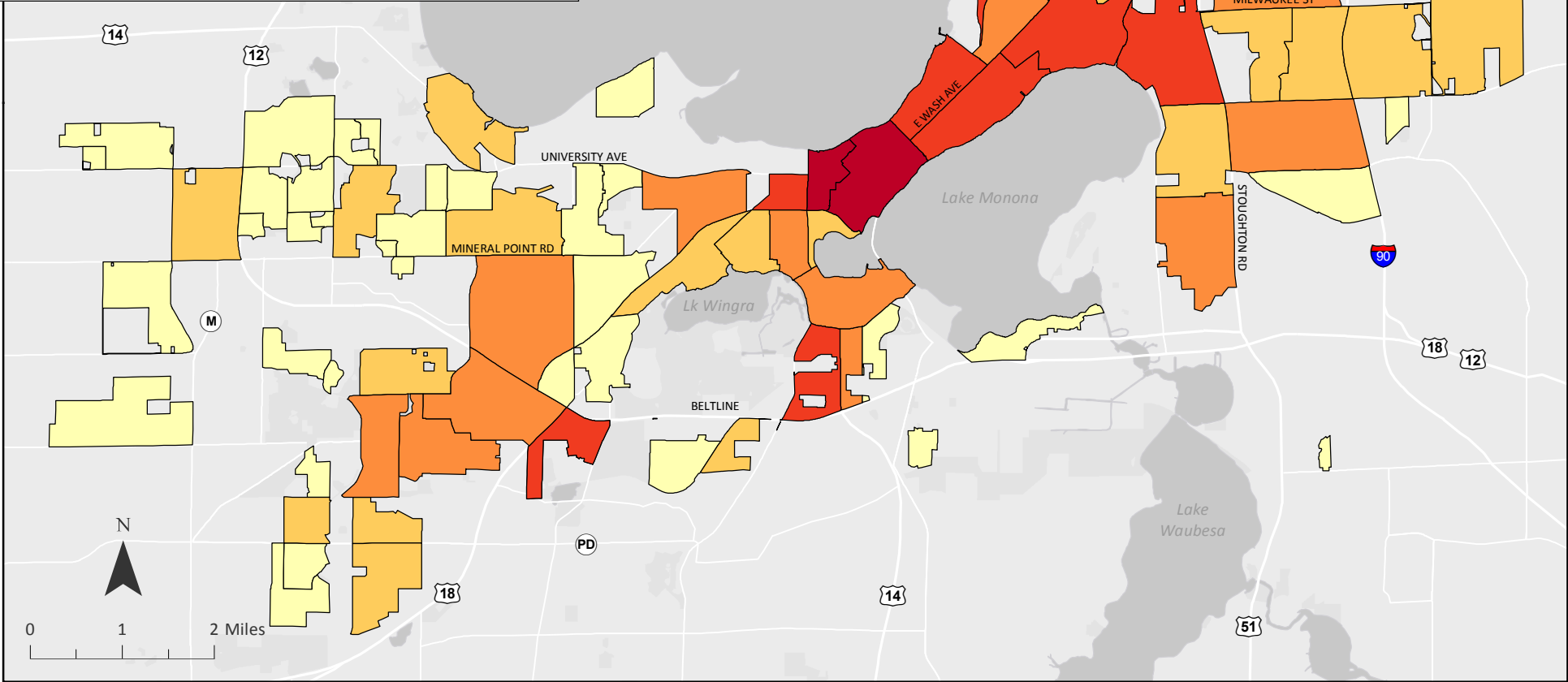

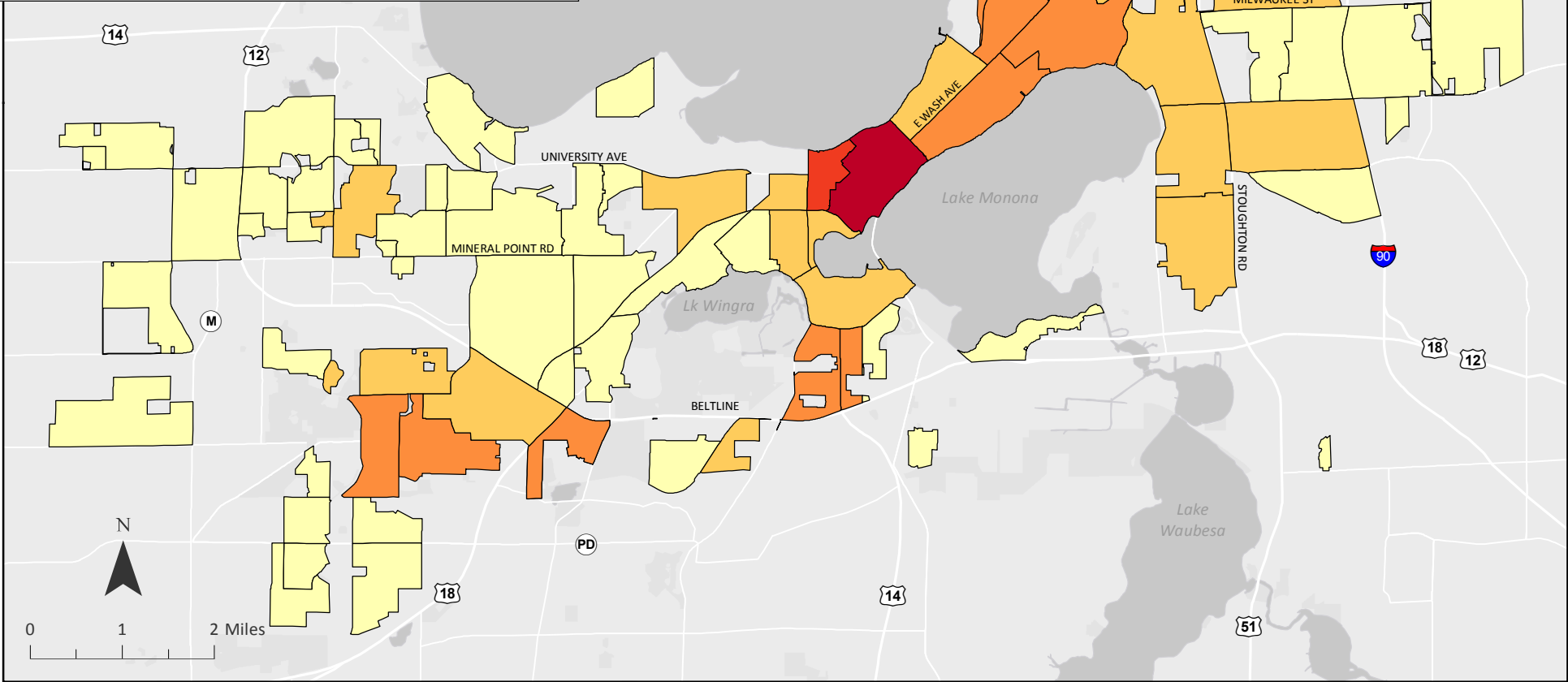

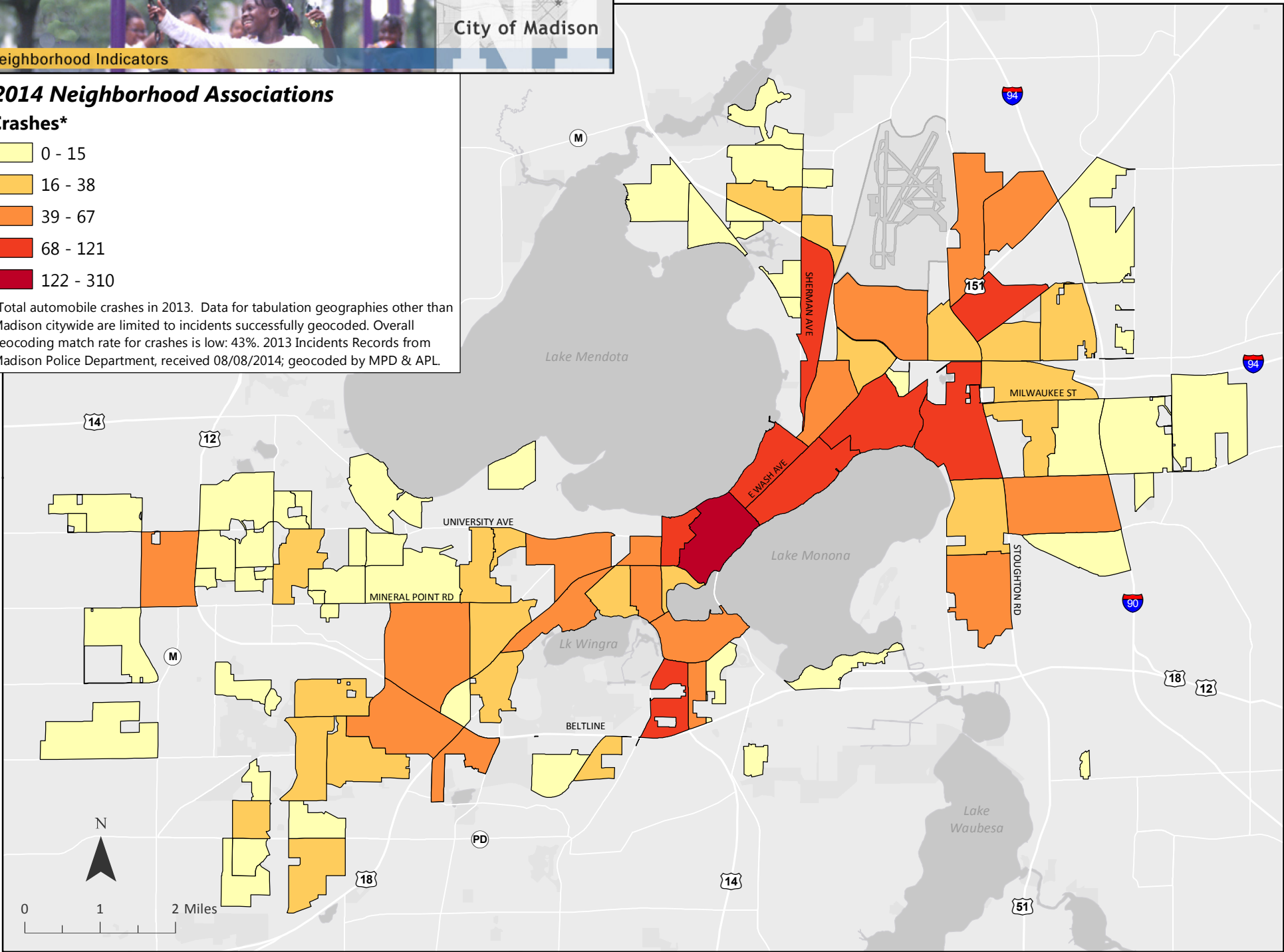

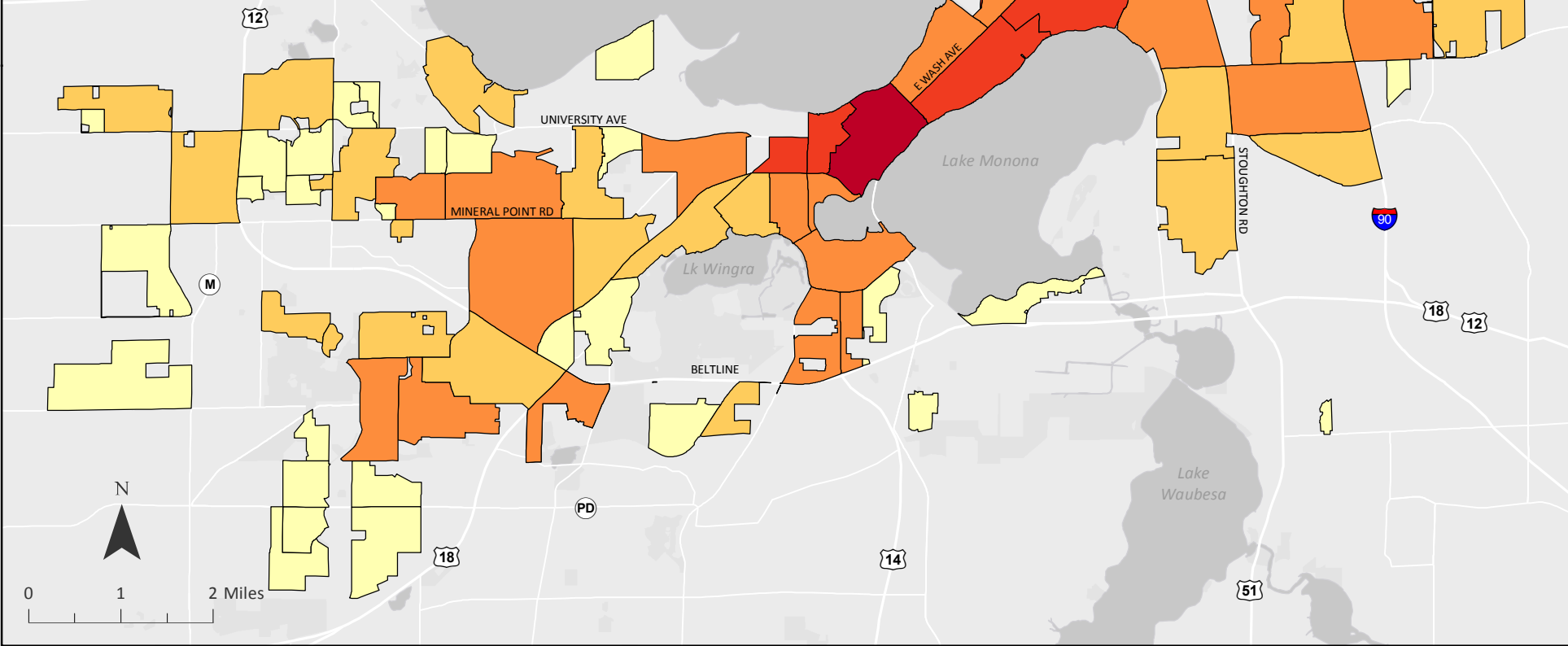

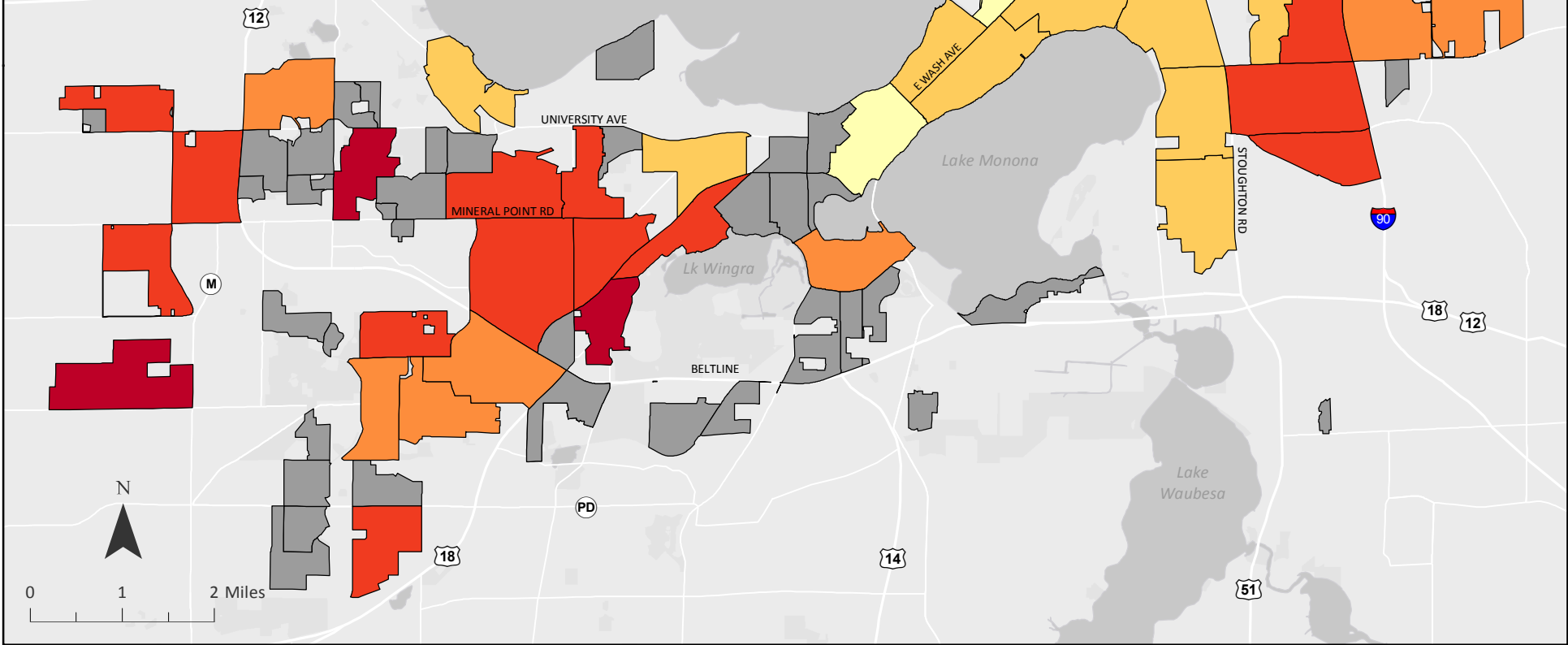

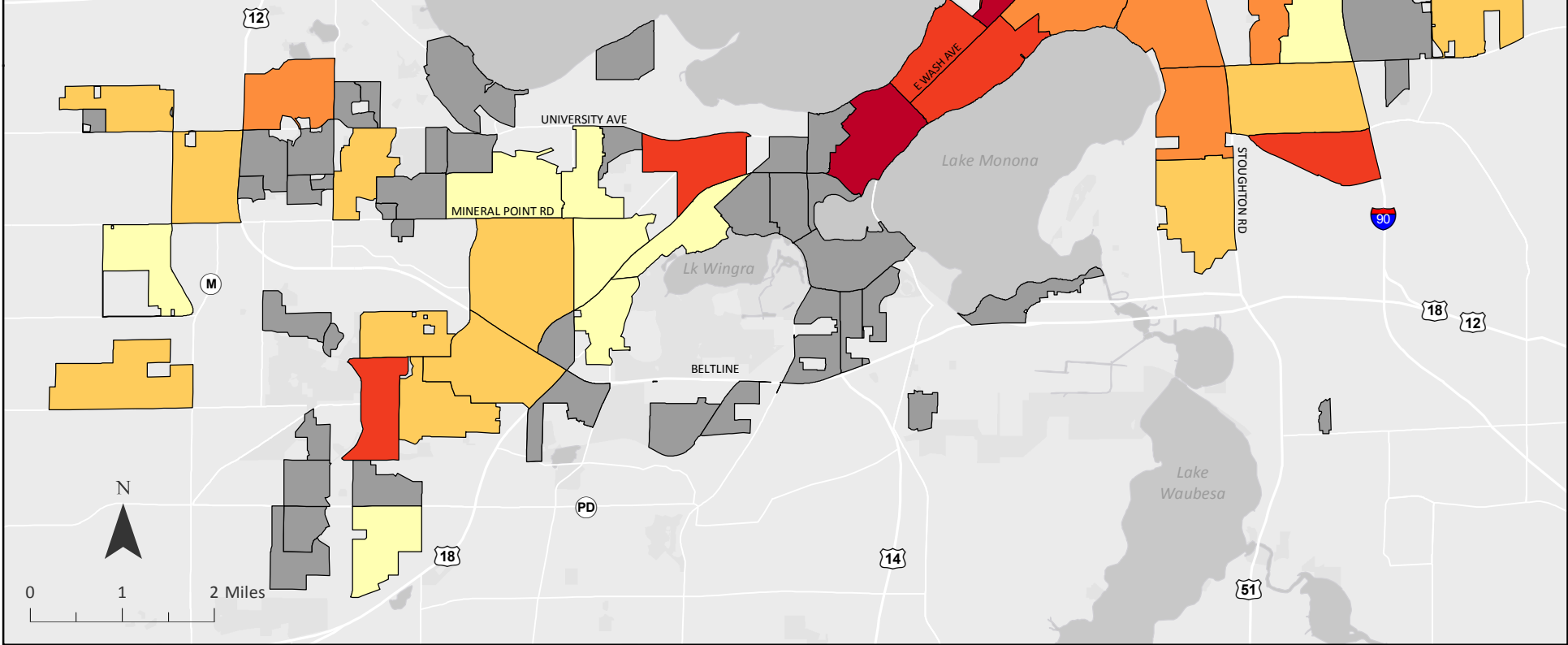

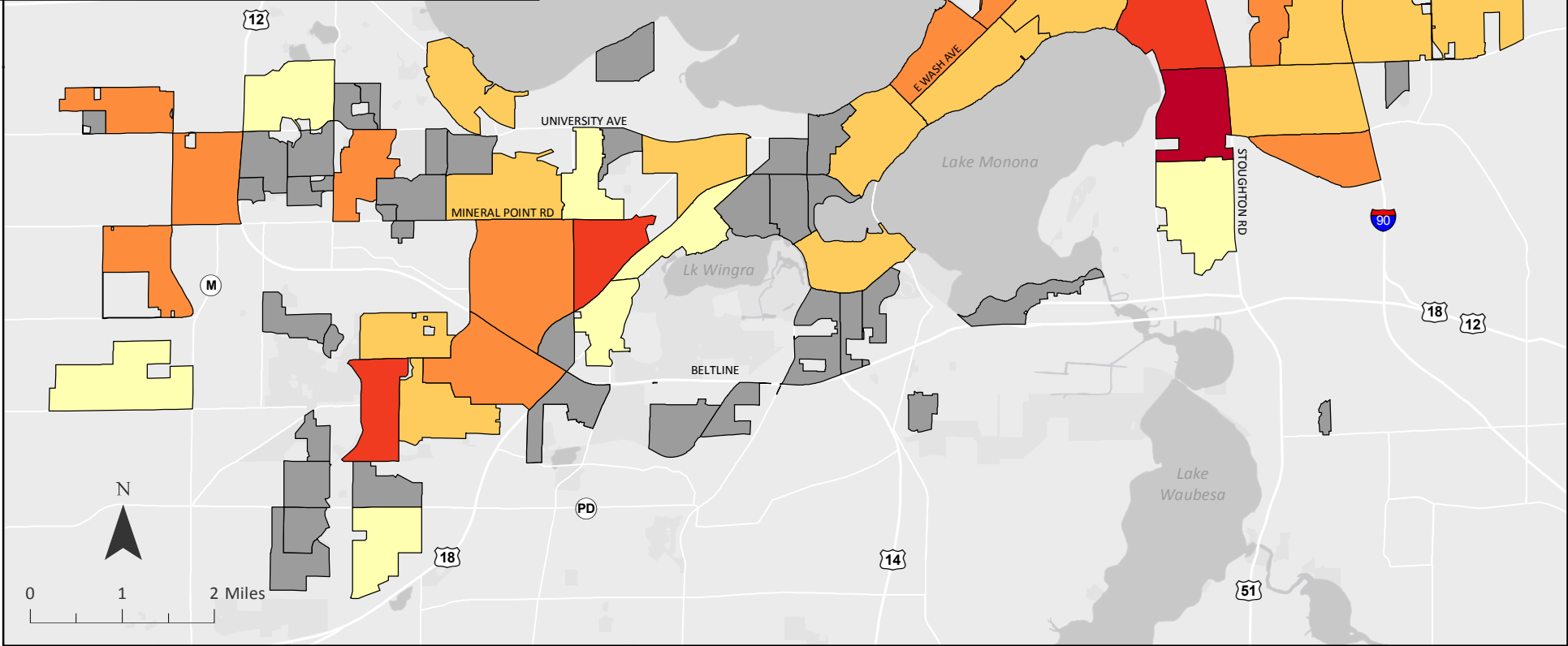

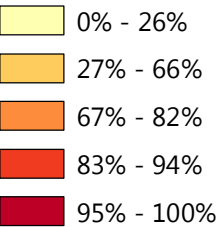

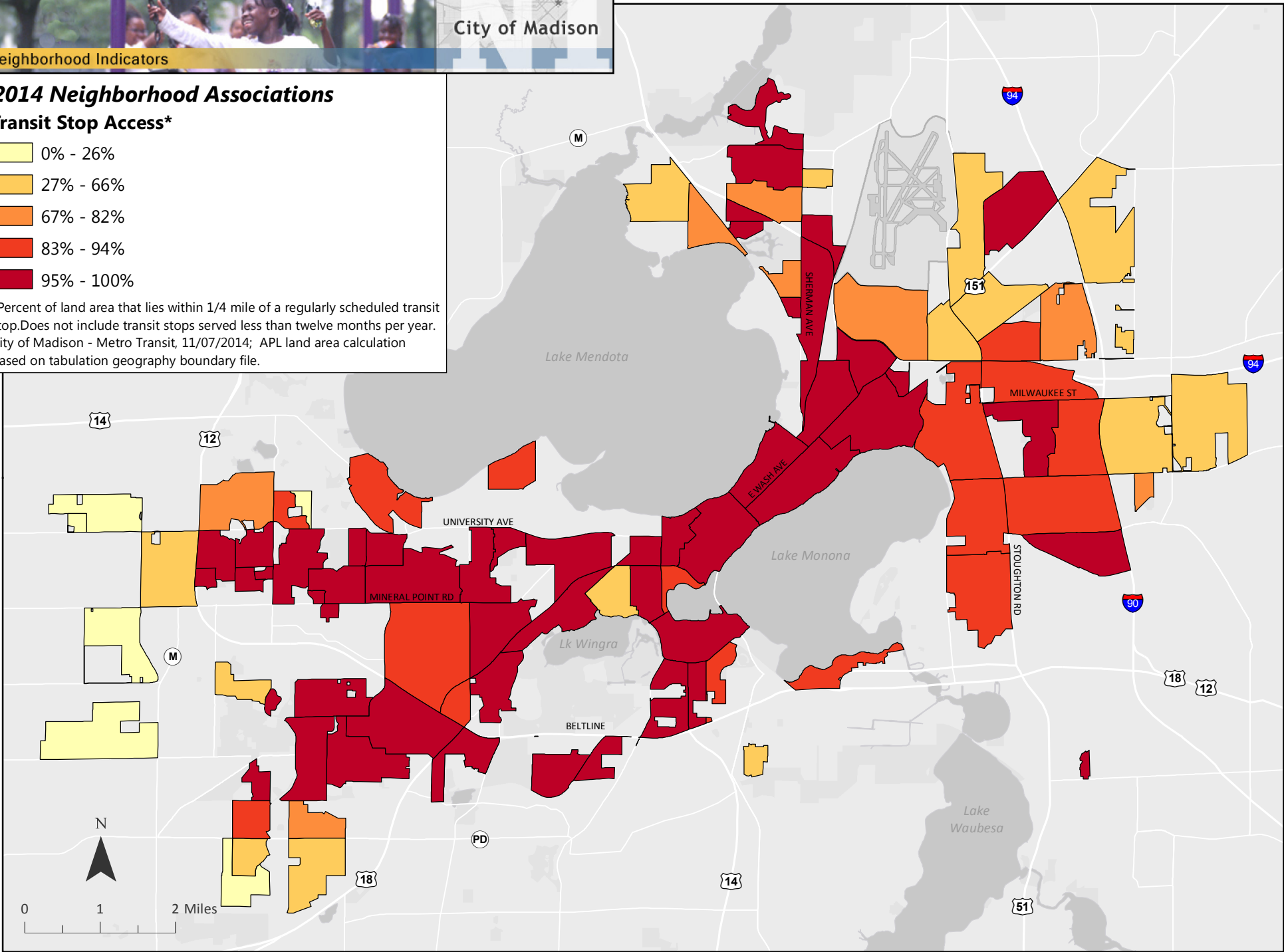

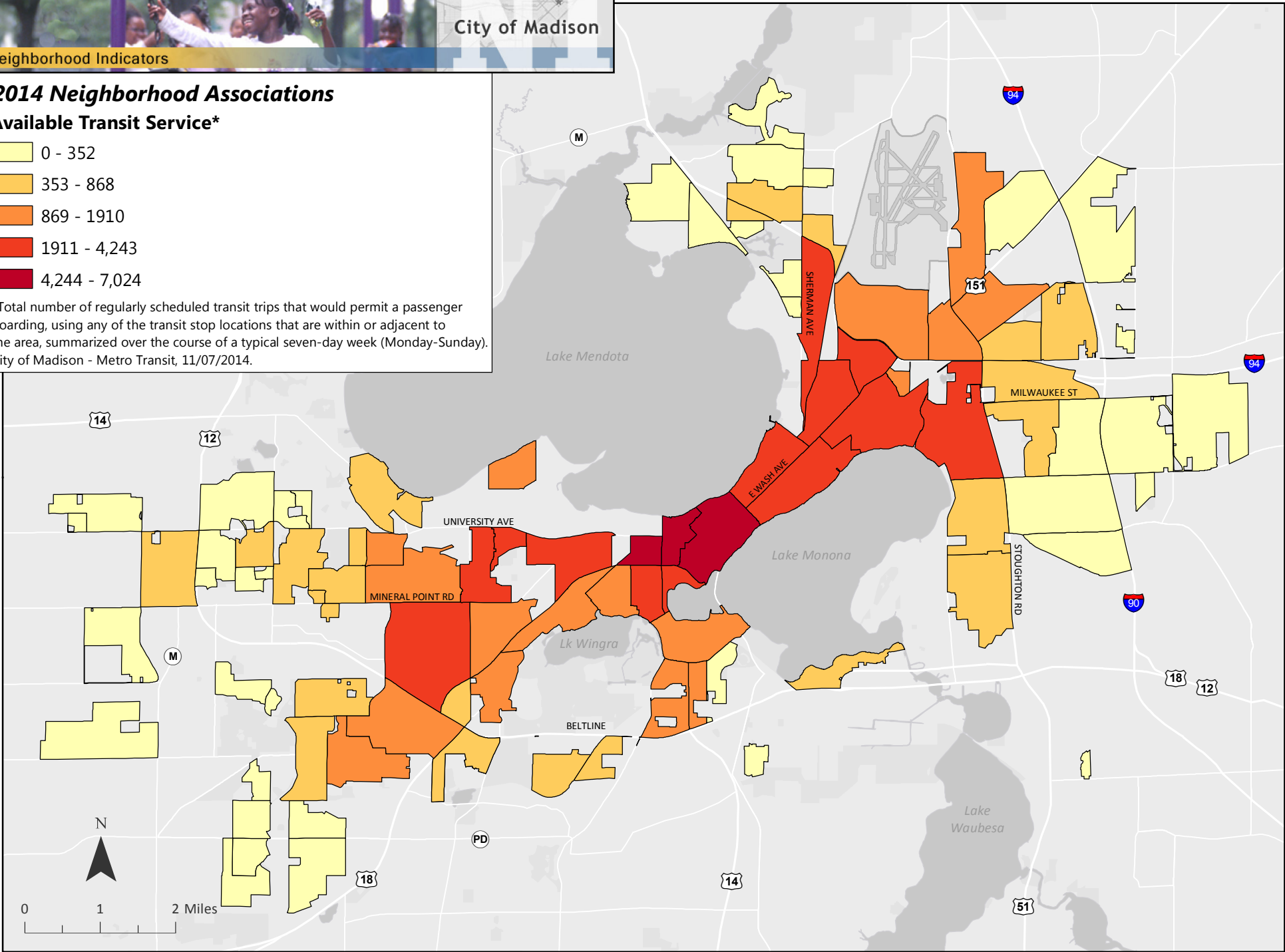

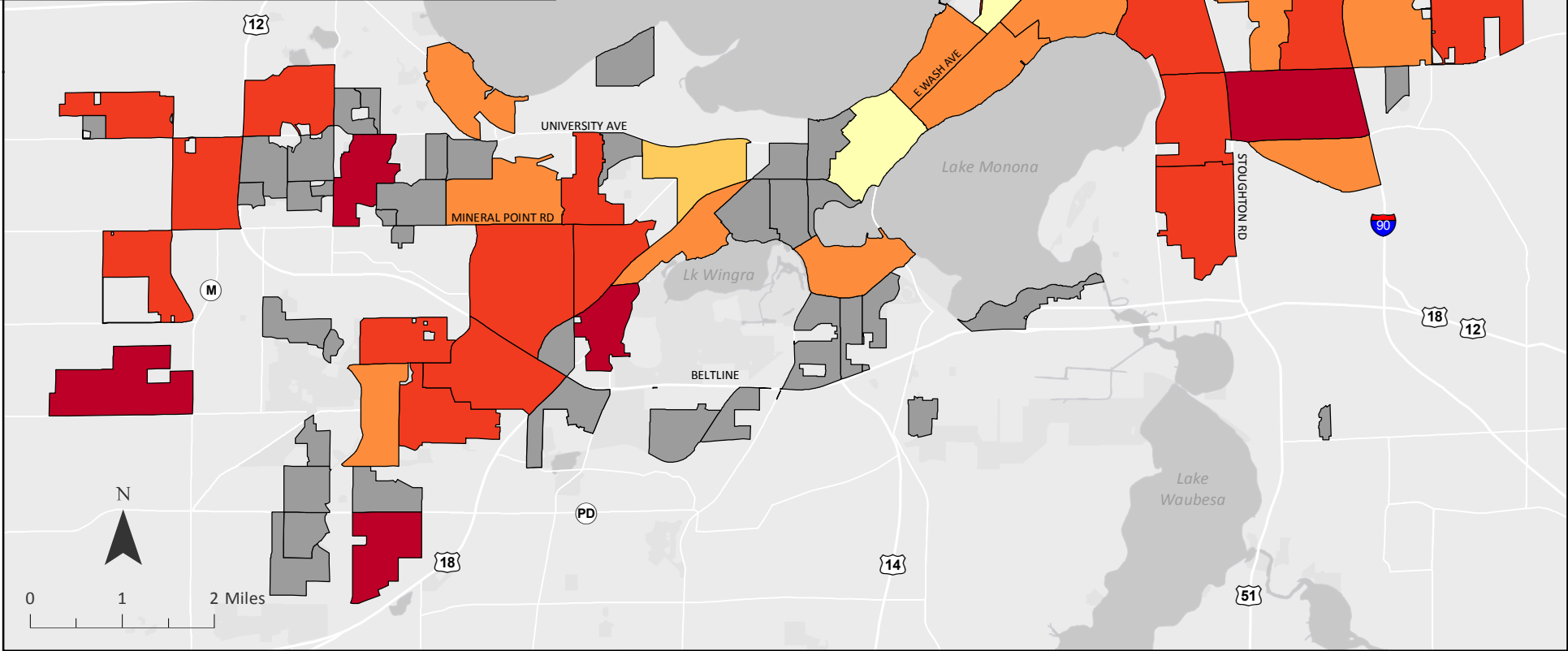

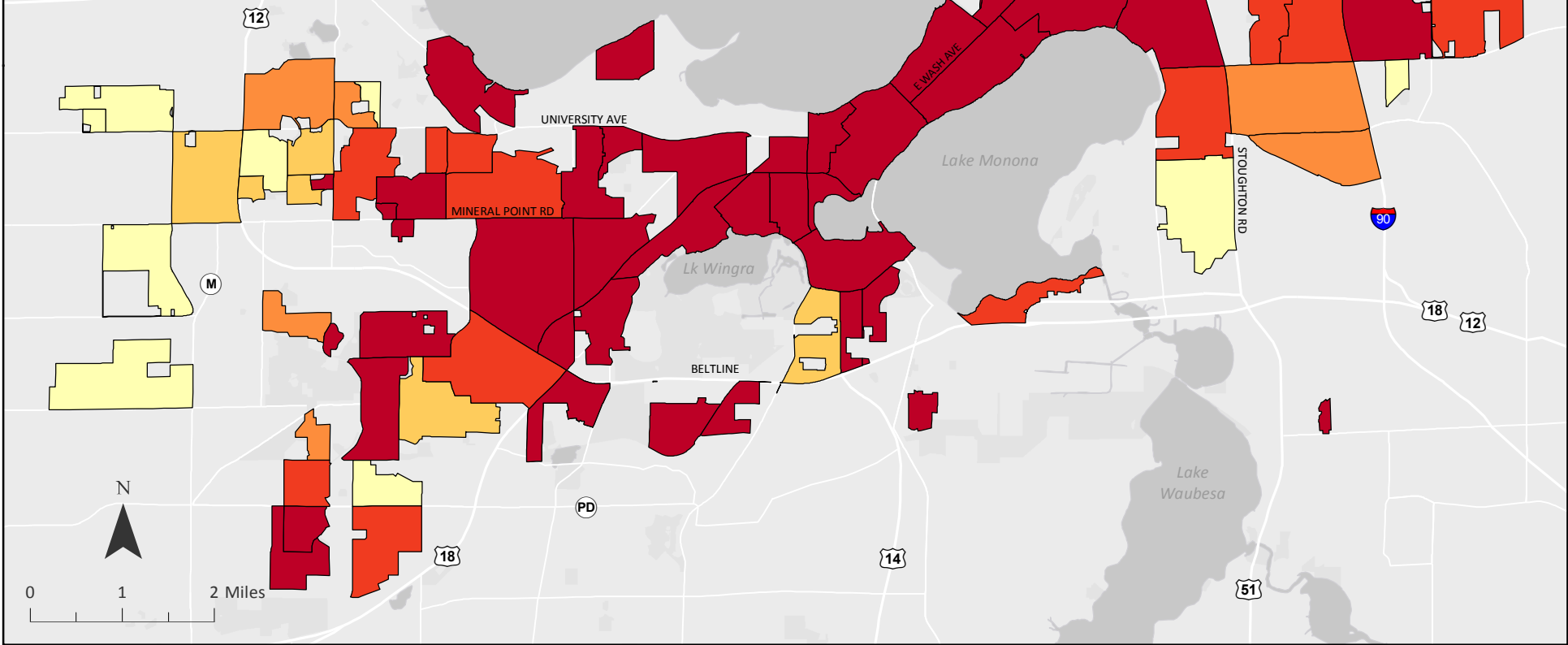

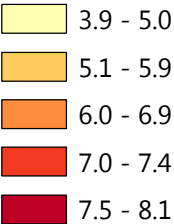
