Land Area - Acres*



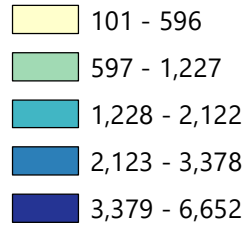

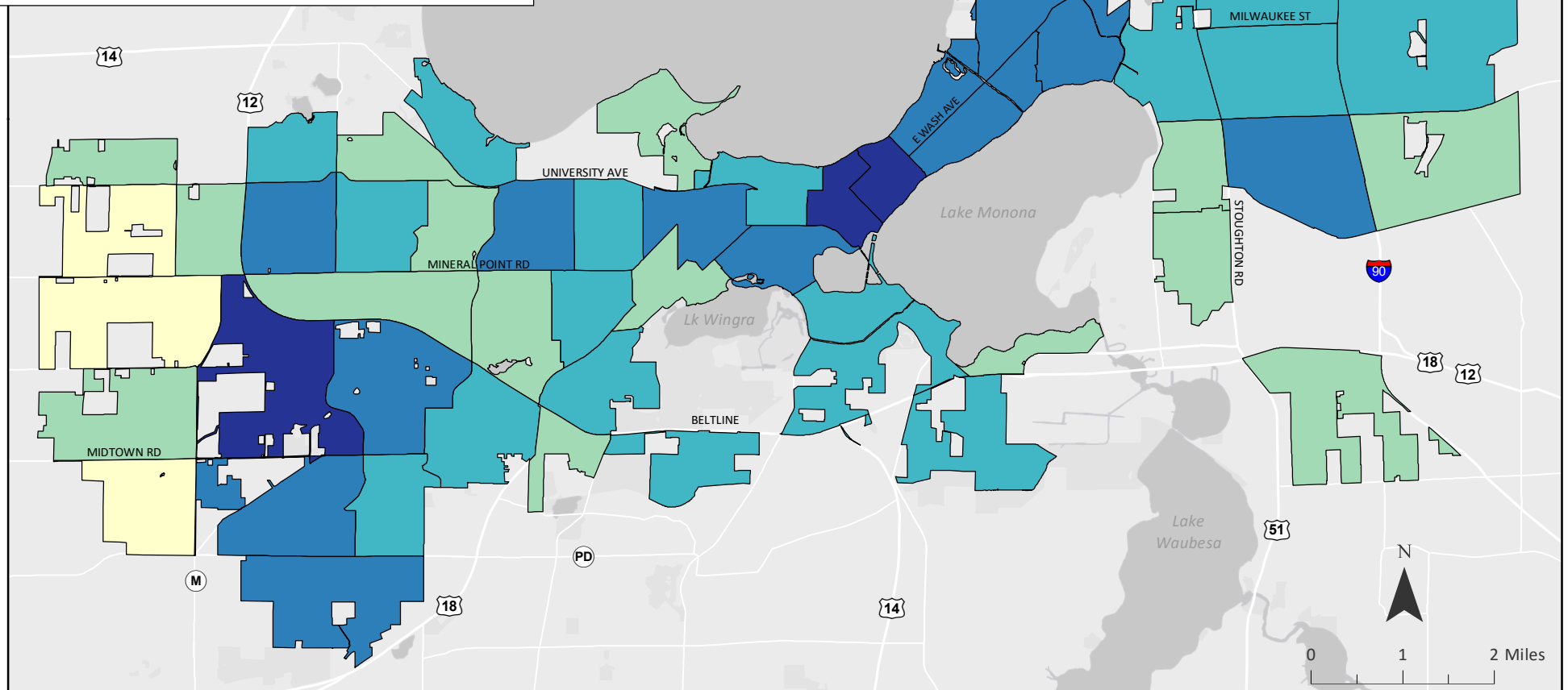


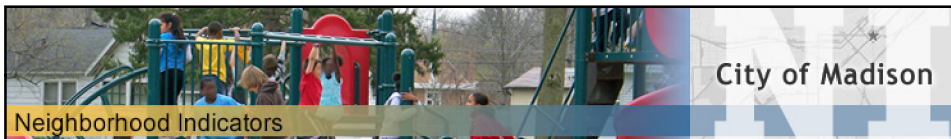

Number of Housing Units - Census 2010*



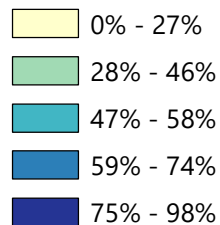

Total Households - Census 2010*



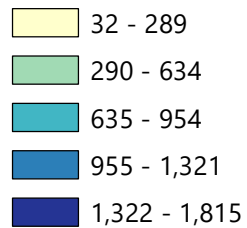

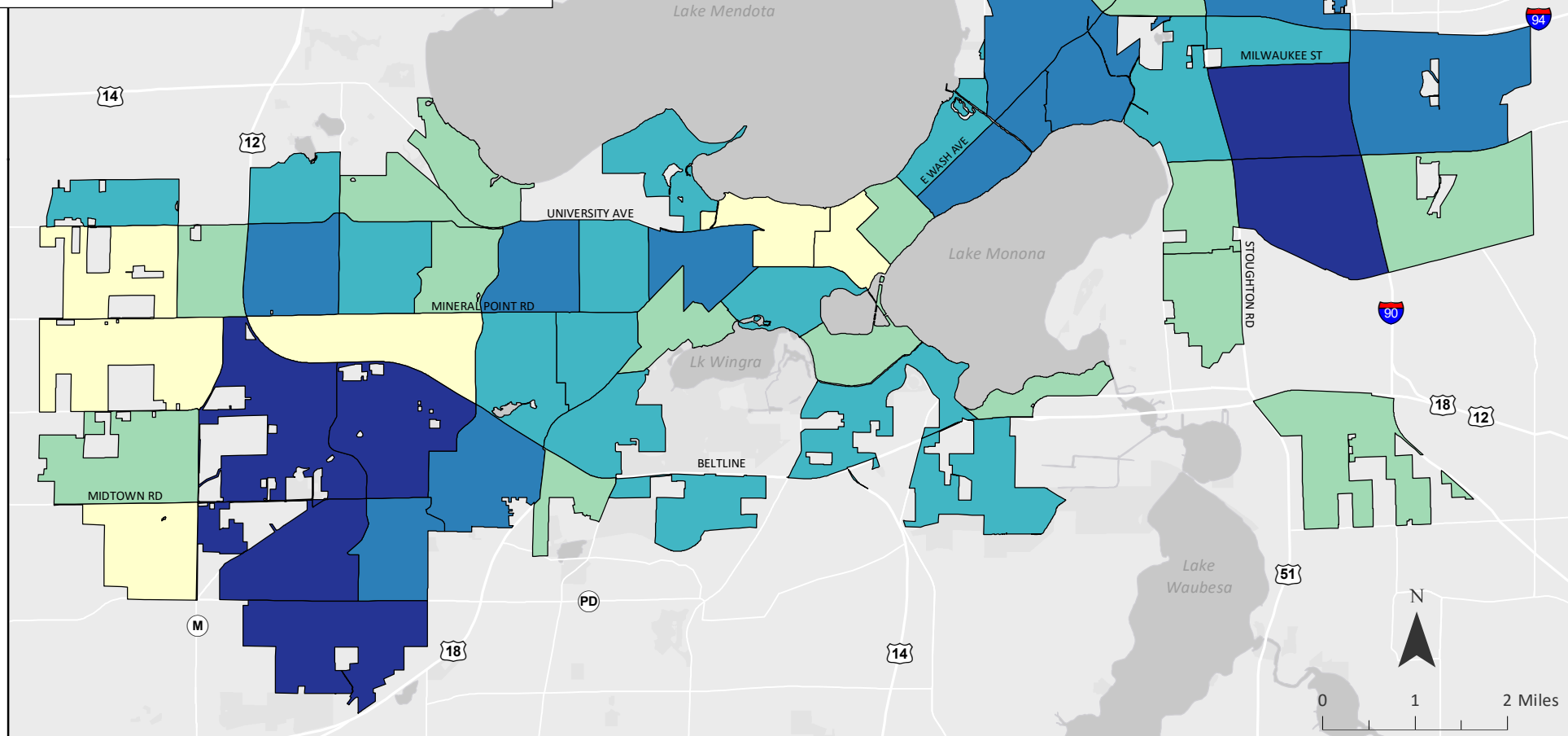


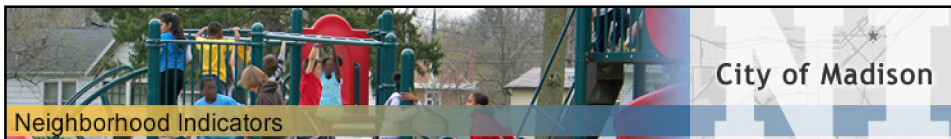

Family Households - Census 2010*



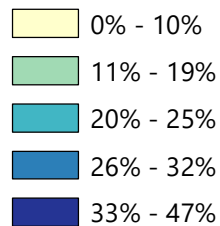

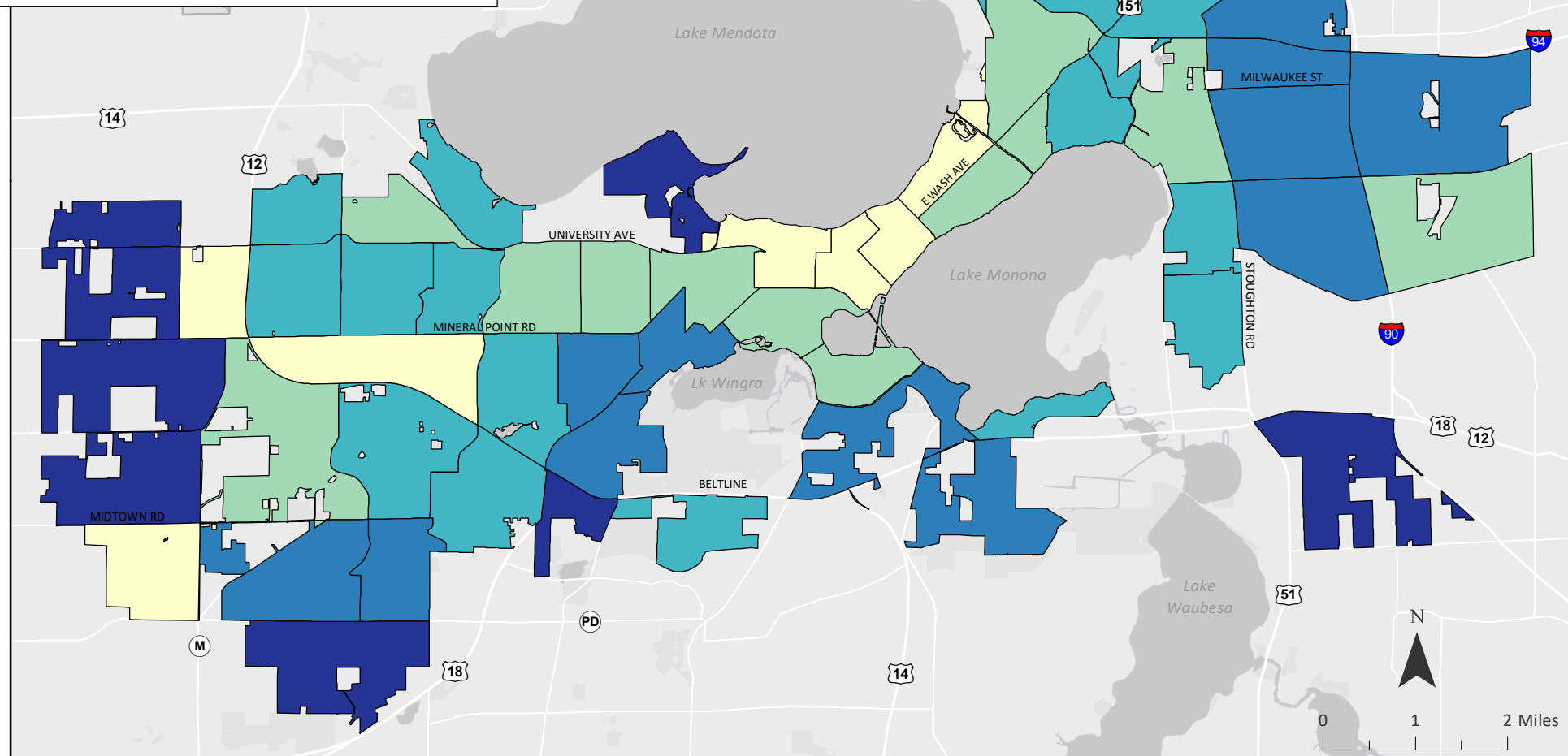


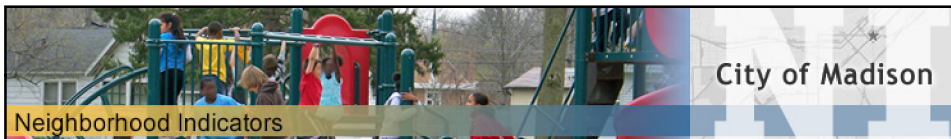

Families with Children - Census 2010*



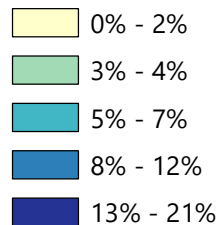

Voter Turn-Out*



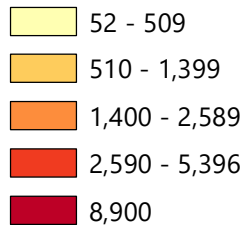

Households with Access to a Vehicle*



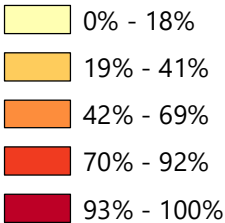

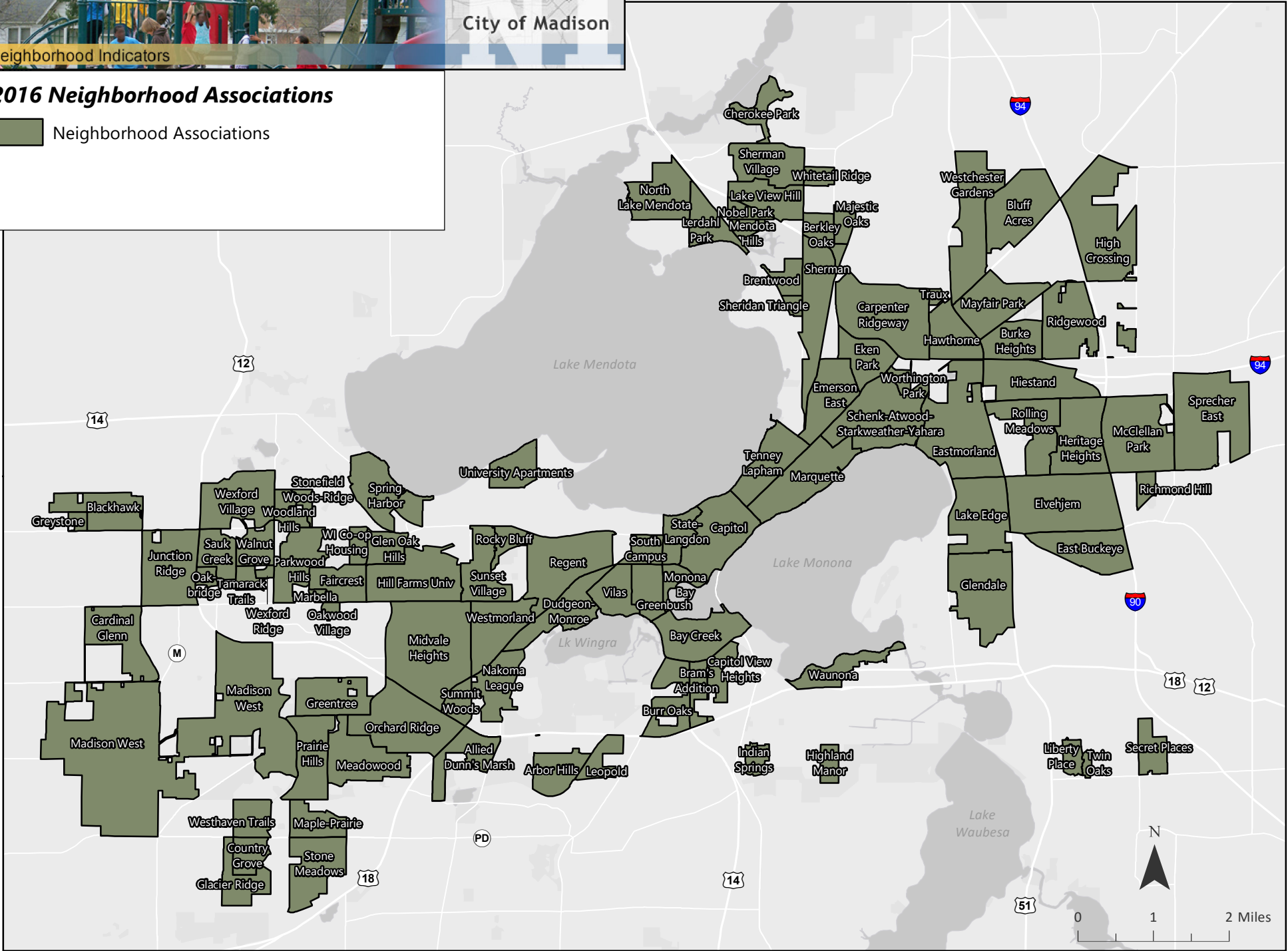

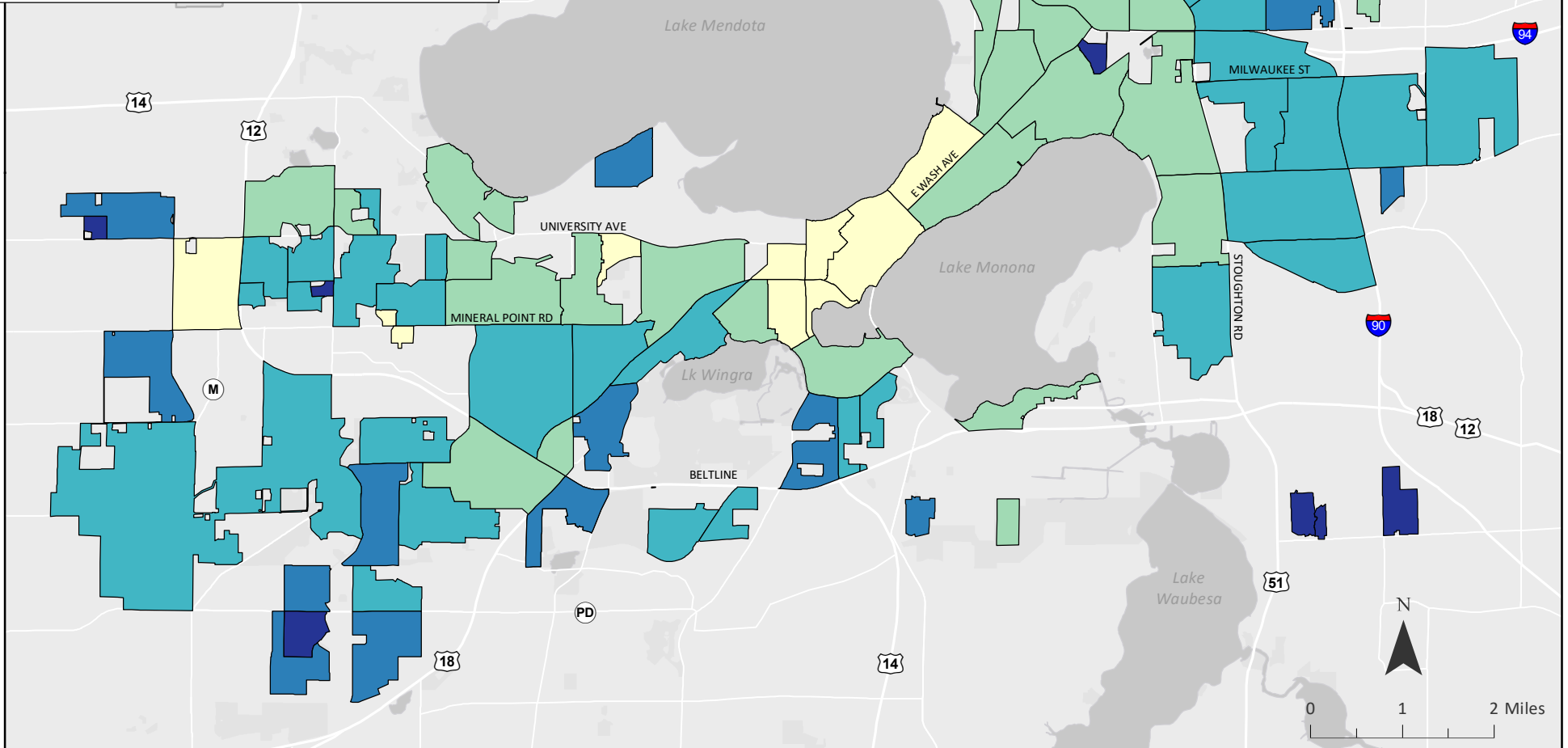

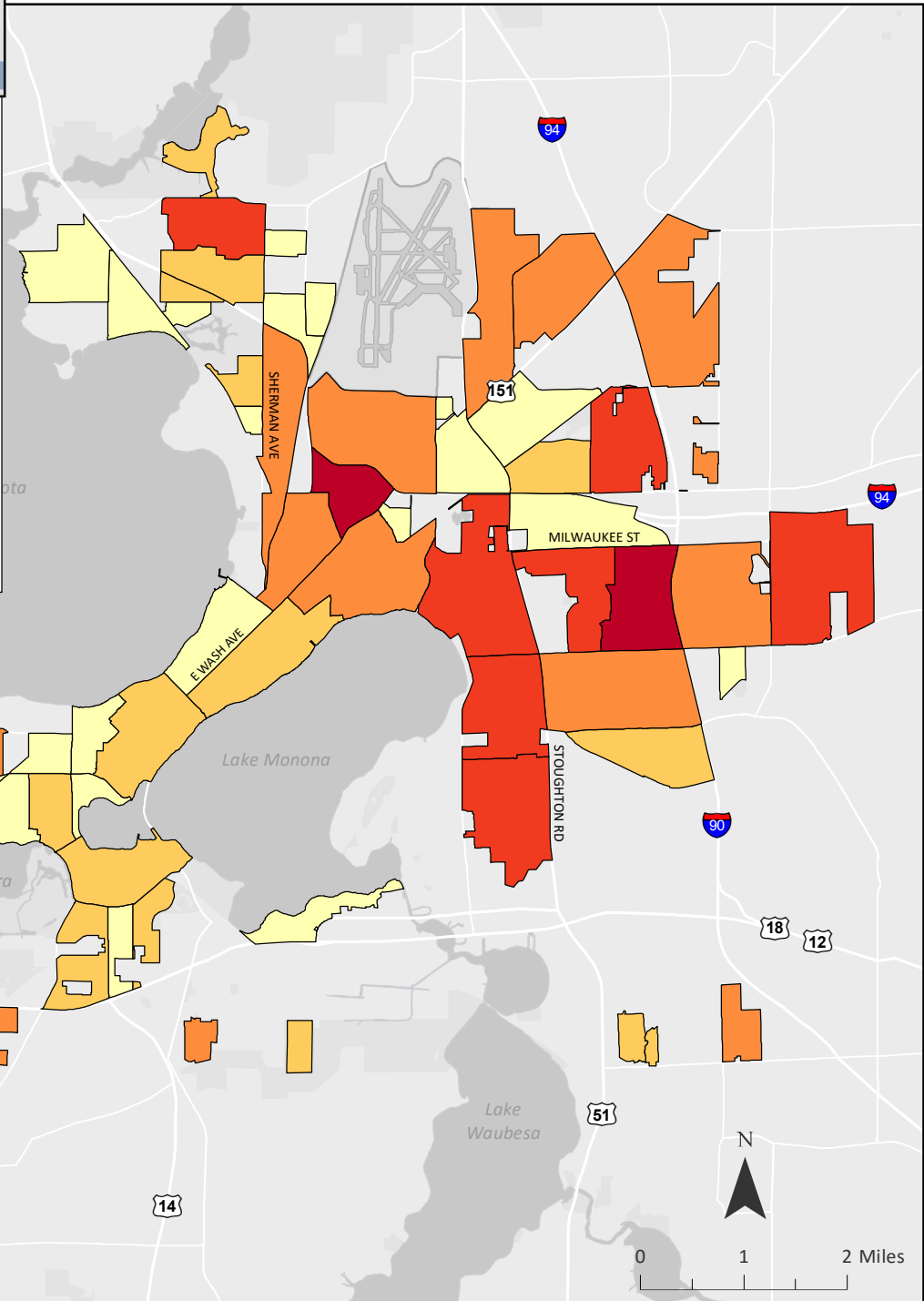

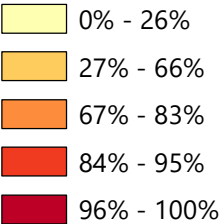
